The five-year projection for the population in the area is 195,981 representing a change of 0.34% annually from 2020 to 2025. Currently, the population is 48.5% male and 51.5% female.

Current median household income is \$56,378 in the area, compared to \$62,203 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$58,833 in five years, compared to \$67,325 for all U.S. households

Current average household income is \$90,660 in this area, compared to \$90,054 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$97,472 in five years, compared to \$99,510 for all U.S. households

Currently, 43.7% of the 91,912 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 46.2%, renter occupied; and 10.1% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.3% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 87,160 housing units in the area - 46.3% owner occupied, 44.7% renter occupied, and 9.0% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 2.39%. Median home value in the area is \$251,606, compared to a median home value of \$235,127 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.35% annually to \$282,642.
