Southridge Square is located within the primary retail corridor servicing the south Des Moines trade area with daily traffic counts exceeding 24,000 vehicles per day along SE 14th St.

Property is strategically located directly across the street from Southridge Mall where there is 5+ major completed/planned developments including 450+ residential units and adaptive reuse of three anchor boxes.

DES MOINES, IOWA

Des Moines is the most populous city in Iowa, the 104th largest city in the United States, and the county Seat of Polk County. Named in numerous 2022 U.S. rankings including #14 Best Places to Live, #5 Best Places to Live for Families, #7 Lowest Cost of Living, Top 25 Up-and-Coming Tech Market, Greater Des Moines is recognized as the location of choice for businesses of all sizes, families, and young professionals. Des Moines population growth be tween 2010 and 2020 of ±16.7% represents a faster growth rate compared to its Midwest peers including Chicago, Omaha, Kansas City, Milwaukee, Minneapolis and St. Louis.


Des Moines is a major center of the US insurance industry and has a sizable financial services and publishing business base. The city was credited as the "number one spot for U.S. insurance companies" in a Business Wire article and named the third-largest "insurance capital" of the world. Nearly 80 insurance companies are headquartered in Greater Des Moines, the highest concentration of insurance employment among U.S. metros. Des Moines is home to two Fortune 500 companies, Principal Financial Group and Casey's General Stores, Inc. Companies are drawn to Des Moines due to the central geographical location, access to highly educated work force, and the low cost of doing business - 13% lower than the national average. Young professionals are drawn to the area due to the access to top employers, affordably housing options, and the ease of commuting in Des Moines, which enjoys one of the shortest average commute times in the nation.

The Des Moines public school system is the largest provider of public education in lowa, with more than 30,000 students and nearly 5,000 teachers and staff at work in more than 60 schools throughout the community. The system has one of the highest high school graduation rates in the country (89.9%). The Des Moines metro boasts 17 higher education institutions and 36% of the regional work force has a bachelor's degree or higher.
