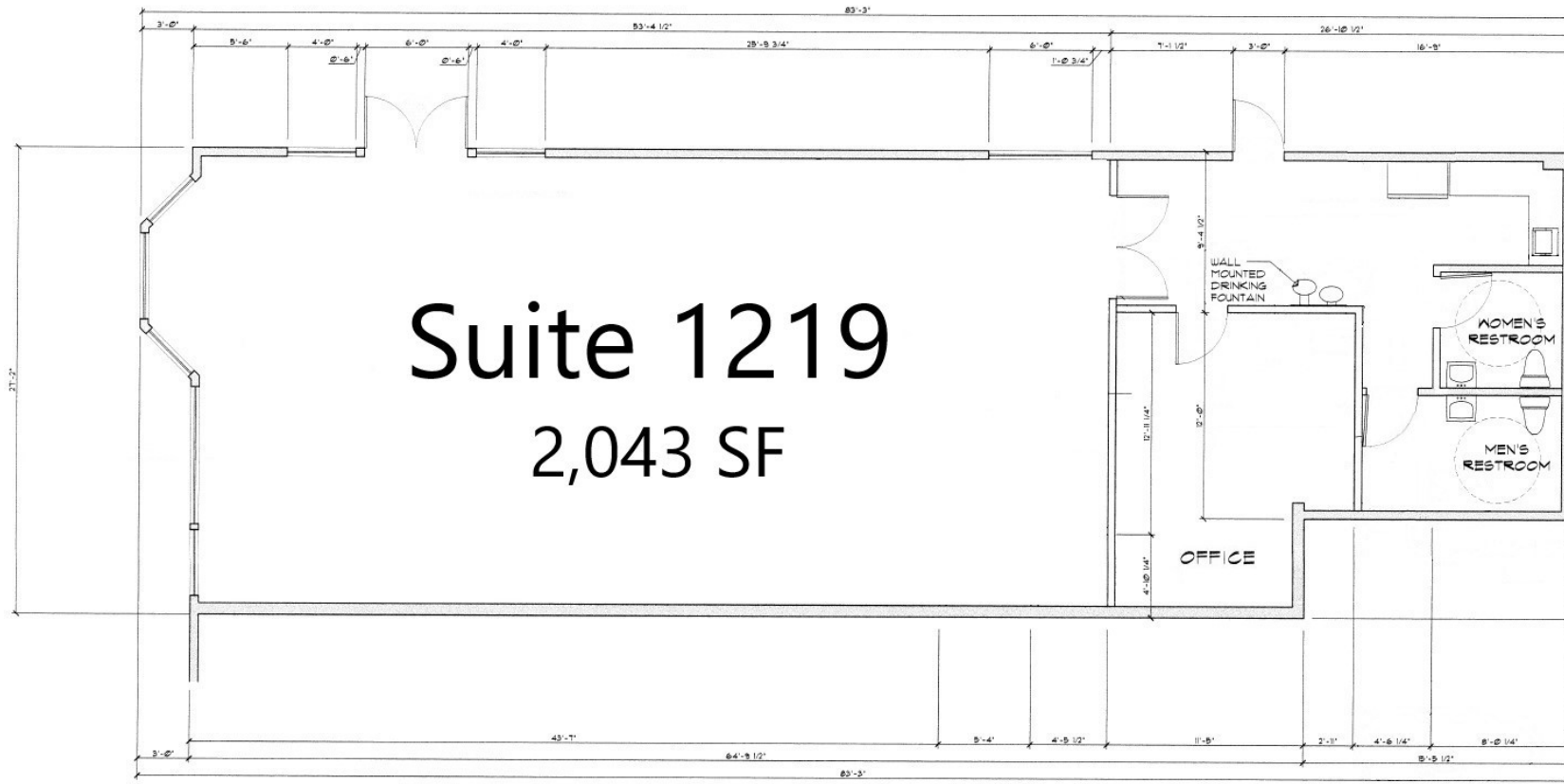

## OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES

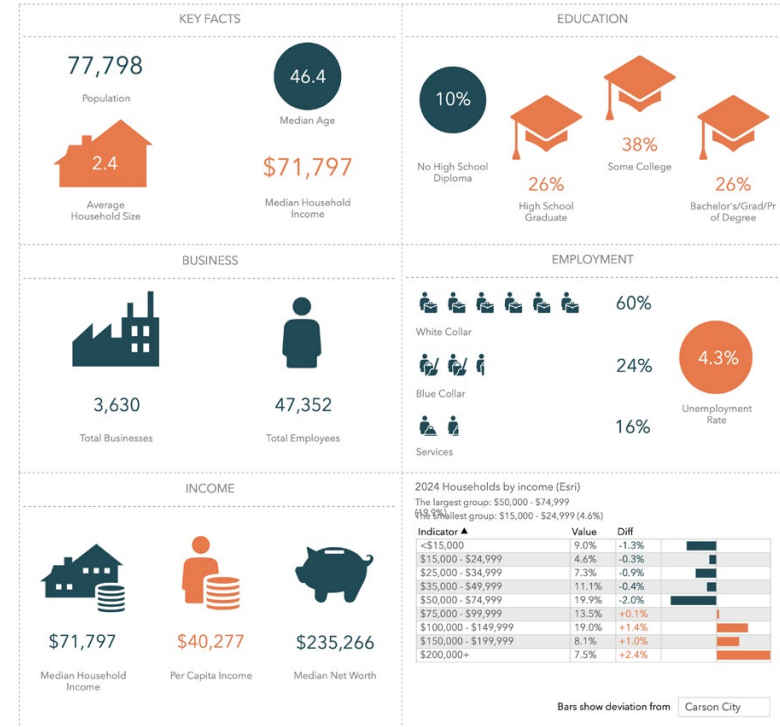
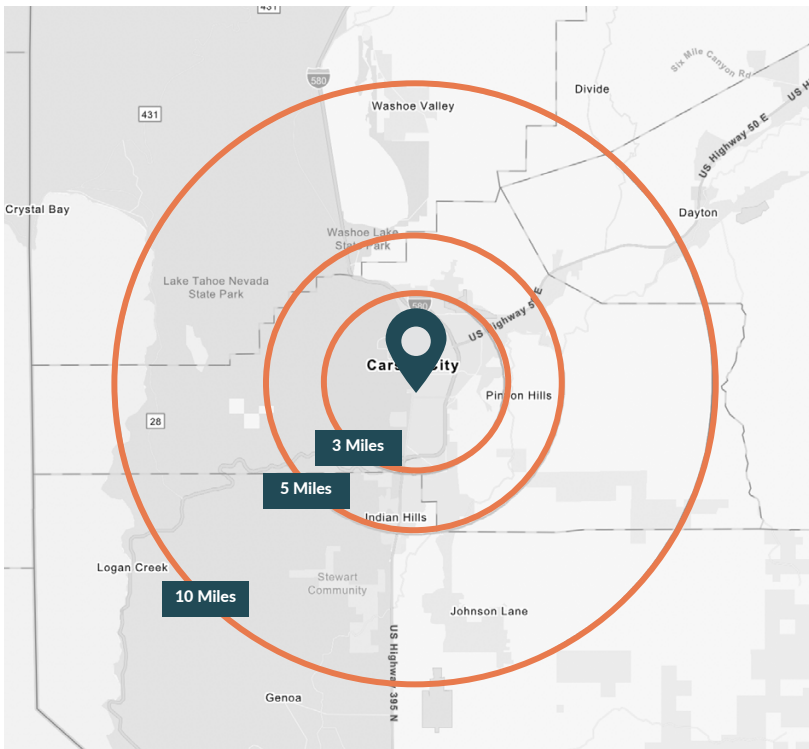
