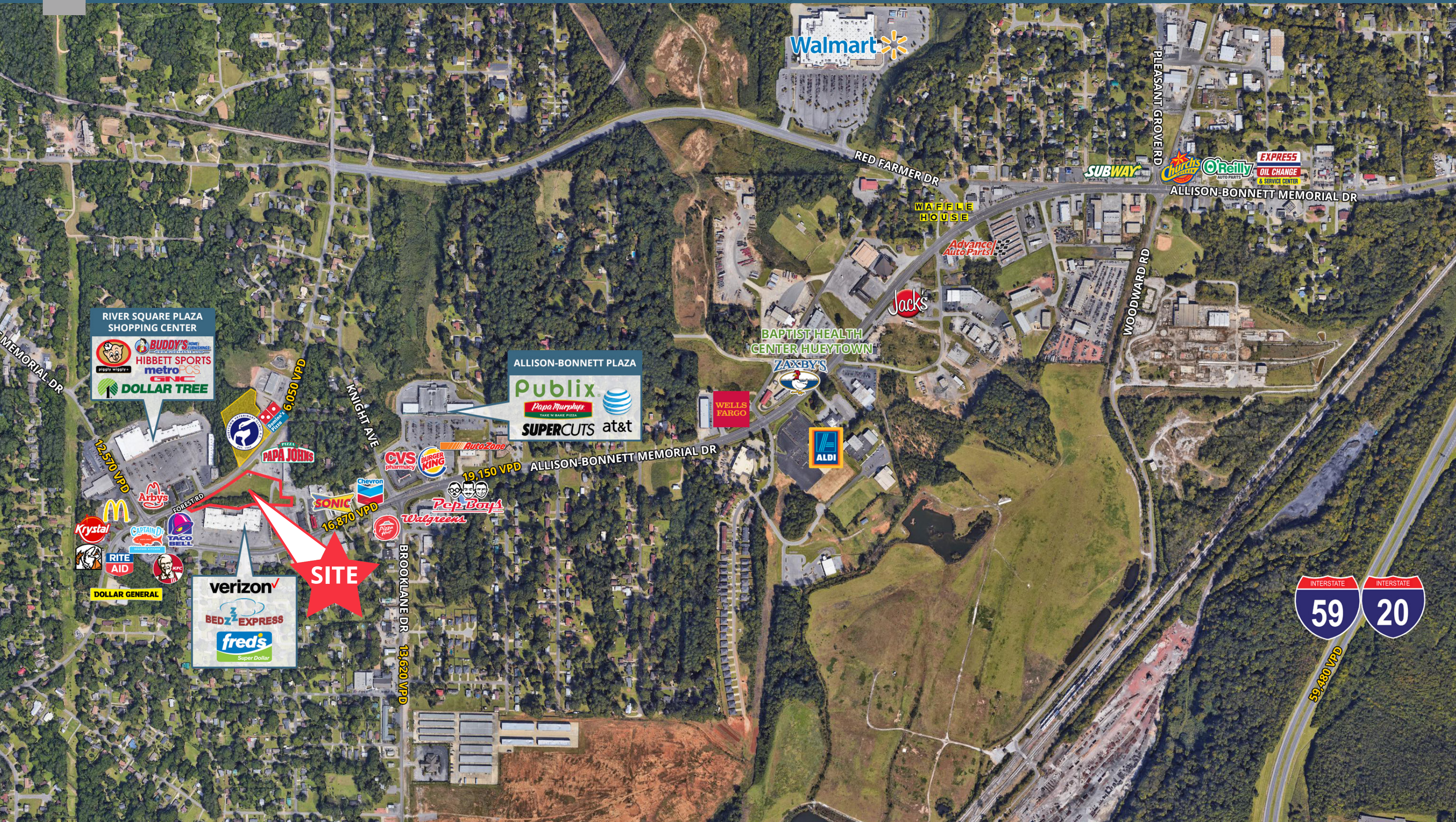

Currently, 56.1% of the 33,205 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 29.6%, renter occupied; and 14.3% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.6% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 33.1% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 32,655 housing units in the area - 60.8% owner occupied, 27.1% renter occupied, and 12.0% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 0.75%. Median home value in the area is \$98,234, compared to a median home value of \$207,344 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 1.70% annually to \$106,851.
