J. S. Hunter Survey, A-110
Madison County, Texas

Being 25.690 acres of land out of a called 32.6 acre tract, also located in the J. S. Hunter Survey, A-110, Madison County, Texas, according to the recorded deed thereof in Volume 124, Page 185 of the Deed Records of Madison County, Texas, said 25.690 acres being more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows:

BEGINNING at a 4" metal fence post found at the most easterly corner of a called 3.482 acre tract as described in volume 1127, page 14 of the Official Records of Madison County, Texas, the most southerly corner of a called 40' strip as described in volume 78, page 41 and 42 of the Deed Records of Madison County, Texas, and the most westerly corner of the herein described tract;

THENCE North 59 degrees 01 minutes 16 seconds East, with the southeasterly line of said 40' strip, a distance of 913.89 feet to a 3/8" iron rod found for the most westerly corner of a called 2.077 acre tract as described in volume 1308, page 218 of the official Records of Madison County, Texas and the most northerly corner of herein described tract;

THENCE South 40 degrees 57 minutes 29 seconds East, with the southwesterly line of said 2.077 acres, a distance of 335.22 feet to a 3/8" iron rod found for the most southerly corner of said 2.077 acres and an interior angle point of herein described tract;

THENCE North 54 degrees 01 minutes 22 seconds East, with the southeasterly line of said 2.077 acres, a distance of 260.25 feet to a 3/8" iron rod found in the southwesterly right of way of Shipp Street for an angle point of herein described tract;

THENCE North 10 degrees 04 minutes 10 seconds East, a distance of 259.84 feet to a railroad x-tie found for corner;

THENCE North 28 degrees 09 minutes 03 seconds East, a distance of 280.77 feet to a 5/8" iron rod set for corner;

THENCE North 21 degrees 52 minutes 31 seconds West, a distance of 248.72 feet to a 30" post oak found for corner;

THENCE South 84 degrees 57 minutes 21 seconds West, a distance of 203.12 feet to a 5/8" iron rod set for corner;

THENCE South 37 degrees 28 minutes 21 seconds West, a distance of 104.00 feet to a 5/8" iron rod set for corner;

THENCE South 34 degrees 20 minutes 32 seconds West, a distance of 124.70 feet to a 30" post oak for corner;

THENCE South 42 degrees 31 minutes 01 seconds West, a distance of 54.90 feet to a 5/8" iron rod set for corner;

THENCE South 36 degrees 17 minutes 15 seconds East, a distance of 189.30 feet to a 3/8" iron rod found for corner;

THENCE South 14 degrees 28 minutes 31 seconds East, a distance of 390.67 feet to a 5/8" iron rod set in the northwesterly right of way of Collard Street for the most southerly corner of said 4.361 acre tract and an angle point of herein described tract;

THENCE South 62 degrees 36 minutes 51 seconds West, with the northwesterly right of way of Collard Street, a distance of 31.28 feet to a 5/8" iron rod set for the most southerly corner of herein described tract;

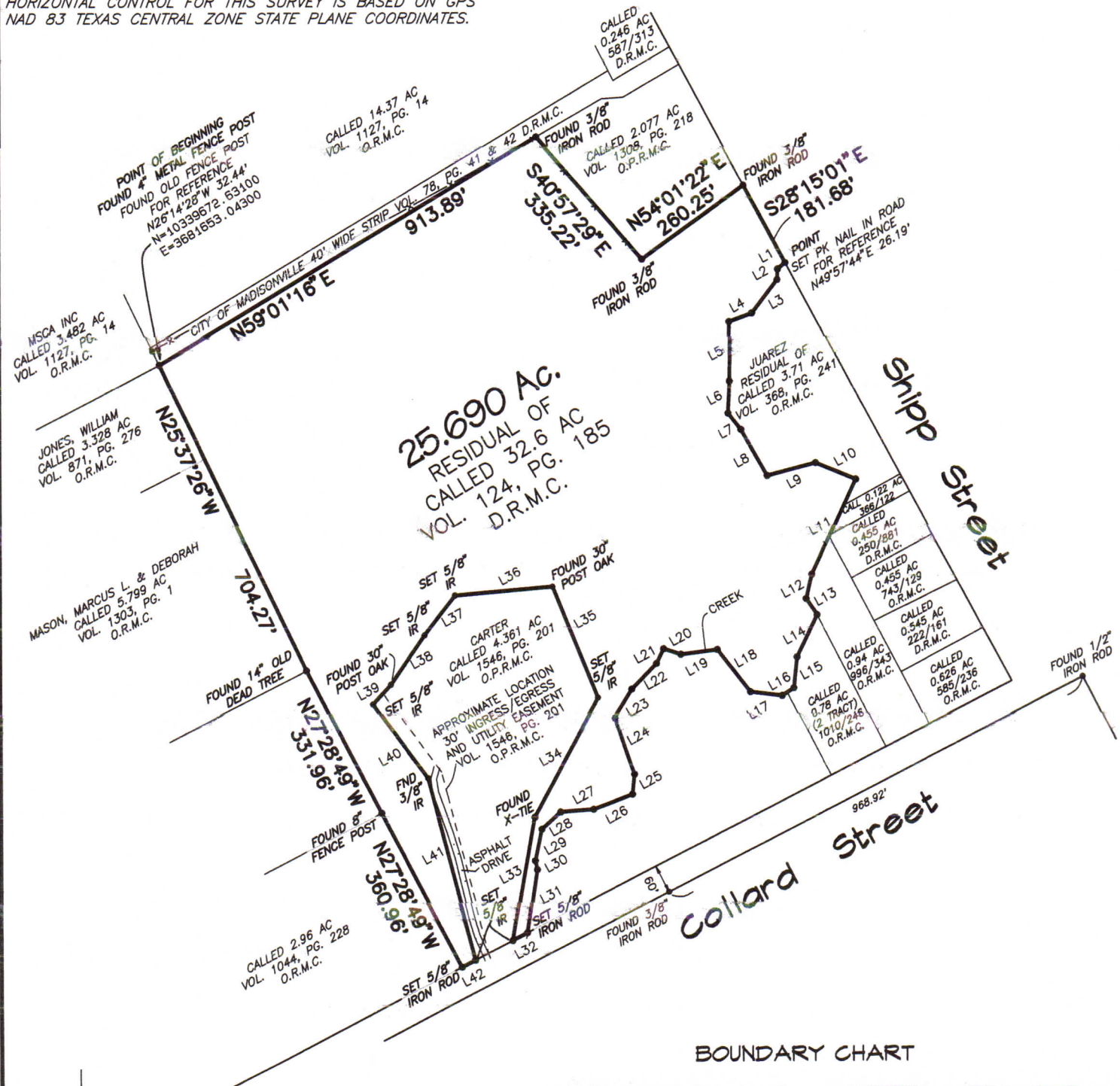
