As of the 2020 census, the population was 2,265,461, with an estimated population of 2,350,611 in 2024. Most of the county population resides in the Las Vegas Census County Divisions across 435 square miles. It is by far the most populous county in Nevada, and the 14th most populous county in the United States. It covers 7% of the state's land area but holds 73% of the state's population, making Nevada one of the most centralized states in the United States.

With jurisdiction over the world-famous Las Vegas Strip and covering an area the size of New Jersey, Clark County is the nation's 14th-largest county. The County is a mix of urban and rural locales that offers the convenience of city living with access to some of the nation's best outdoor recreational areas just a short drive away.

Clark County employs more than 10,000 people over 38 departments. The County has an annual budget of \$11.4 billion, which surpasses that of the state government.

Synopsis

The Las Vegas metropolitan area is home to many sports, most of which take place in the unincorporated communities around Las Vegas rather than in the city itself.

The Las Vegas Valley has three major league professional teams: the Vegas Golden Knights of the NHL, which began play in 2017 as the region's first major pro team, the Las Vegas Raiders of the NFL which began play in 2020, and the Las Vegas Aces of the WNBA, which began play in 2018.

Las Vegas is home to three minor league sports teams: the Las Vegas Aviators of Minor League Baseball, the Las Vegas Lights FC of the USL Championship, the league at the second level of the U.S. men's soccer league system, and the Henderson Silver Knights of the American Hockey League, the league at the second level of the NHL. The Las Vegas Lights are currently the only team playing in the City of Las Vegas, at the city-owned Cashman Field.



Education & Workforce Development

Southern Nevada's post-secondary education and training institutions have significantly increased their offerings.

Notably, the University of Nevada, Las Vegas (UNLV) doubled its research and development (R&D) performance over the last decade and reached R1 status in 2018, the highest classification for research universities. Additionally, the newly formed UNLV School of Medicine started class in 2017.

Nevada State College (NSC) more than double its degree awards since 2011, with especially strong growth in awards to racial and ethnic minorities, and in health professions that support a key regional target industry.

The College of Southern Nevada (CSN) was named as a Leader College of Distinction by national non-profit network Achieving the Dream in 2019 for its work on improving student outcomes and reducing student achievement gaps.

Innovation Ecosystem

In 2016, Las Vegas established an Innovation District to spur smart-city technology infrastructure and launched the International Innovation Center @ Vegas (IIC@V) incubator to support development of high priority emerging technologies.

The Las Vegas-based Nevada Institute for Autonomous Systems was designated in 2013 as one of six official unmanned aircraft systems (UAS) test sites in the United States, and the UNLV Tech Park has quickly emerged as a hub for regional innovation.

In July 2019, Google broke ground on a \$600 million data center, and in October 2019 Switch announced a partnership with UNLV to support sports science R&D. Switch also expanded its footprint in Southern Nevada to 4.6M SF of data center space.

The Las Vegas Convention and Visitors Authority (LVCVA) partnered with the Boring Company to build a high-speed electric autonomous people mover for the Las Vegas Convention Center.
