## PROPERTY DESCRIPTION

Property One is pleased to present a value-add investment or owner-user opportunity at 4201 Woodland Drive, New Orleans, Louisiana. This six-story, ±120,000 SF institutional/medical facility sits on approximately ±8.1 acres on the West Bank and was originally constructed in 1973 as a 118-bed nursing home, with partial renovations completed in 2007.

Zoned EC (Educational Campus District), the property is well suited for Medical or Psychiatric Inpatient Rehabilitation, Moderate- to High-Care Assisted Living, or other healthcare and institutional uses, with potential for public and private partnerships with nearby medical and educational institutions.

Currently 26.5% occupied, the facility offers significant upside through lease-up, redevelopment, or owner-user conversion. With over 1,251 feet of frontage along General DeGaulle Drive, the property benefits from excellent visibility, access, and connectivity throughout the greater New Orleans market.

## LOCATION DESCRIPTION

Prime medical services location in New Orleans, Louisiana, ideal for a Medical Office Building or Specialty Hospital, including Senior or Psychiatric Care facilities. Located in Algiers on the West Bank, the property sits on a highly visible corner at Woodland Avenue and General DeGaulle Drive, offering direct access to General DeGaulle, a major corridor serving Gretna, Harvey, Marrero, Belle Chasse, and portions of Jefferson and Plaquemines Parishes.

Adjacent to the University of Holy Cross, the site is surrounded by established medical providers and community amenities within a peaceful neighborhood. Just minutes from the French Quarter, the property offers an attractive balance of accessibility, healthcare demand, and proximity to New Orleans' cultural and economic center.

# AREA OVERVIEW



## New Orleans Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) – Economic Highlights

The New Orleans MSA is the largest metropolitan area in Louisiana, supporting approximately 586,200 non-farm workers and serving as a major economic engine for the state. Strategically located at the “toe of the boot” near the mouth of the Mississippi River, the region benefits from one of the world’s most extensive port systems, ranking among the largest globally in total tonnage moved. This infrastructure supports robust trade, logistics, and industrial activity.

The MSA is a regional hub for healthcare and medical research, anchored by a nationally recognized medical district. Major institutions include LSU Health Sciences Center New Orleans, the VA Medical Center, University Medical Center New Orleans, Ochsner Health, LCMC Health, and Tulane Medical Center, collectively providing advanced care, medical education, and research for both veterans and civilians across the Gulf South.

Higher education plays a significant role in the area’s economy and workforce development. The region is home to several universities, including Tulane University, the University of New Orleans, and Loyola University New Orleans, all of which contribute to research, innovation, and a steady pipeline of skilled talent.

Tourism remains a cornerstone of the local economy, with New Orleans attracting millions of visitors annually to the historic French Quarter, world-renowned cuisine and culture, and a substantial gaming industry. The MSA’s gaming sector is anchored by Louisiana’s only land-based casino, additional riverboat casinos, and the Fair Grounds Race Course.

The region also maintains a strong energy and industrial presence, including several major refineries—among them the third-largest refinery in the United States—as well as numerous chemical manufacturing firms. Global energy leaders such as Chevron and Shell maintain a significant presence within the MSA.

In recent years, New Orleans has experienced growing momentum in the technology and innovation sectors, supported by startup accelerators, digital media firms, and a skilled talent pipeline emerging from local universities and medical research institutions. Together, these diverse economic drivers position the New Orleans MSA as a resilient, multifaceted market with long-term growth potential.

EC (Educational Campus District) zoning supports a wide range of healthcare and institutional uses and benefits from proximity to the University of Holy Cross and surrounding medical providers.



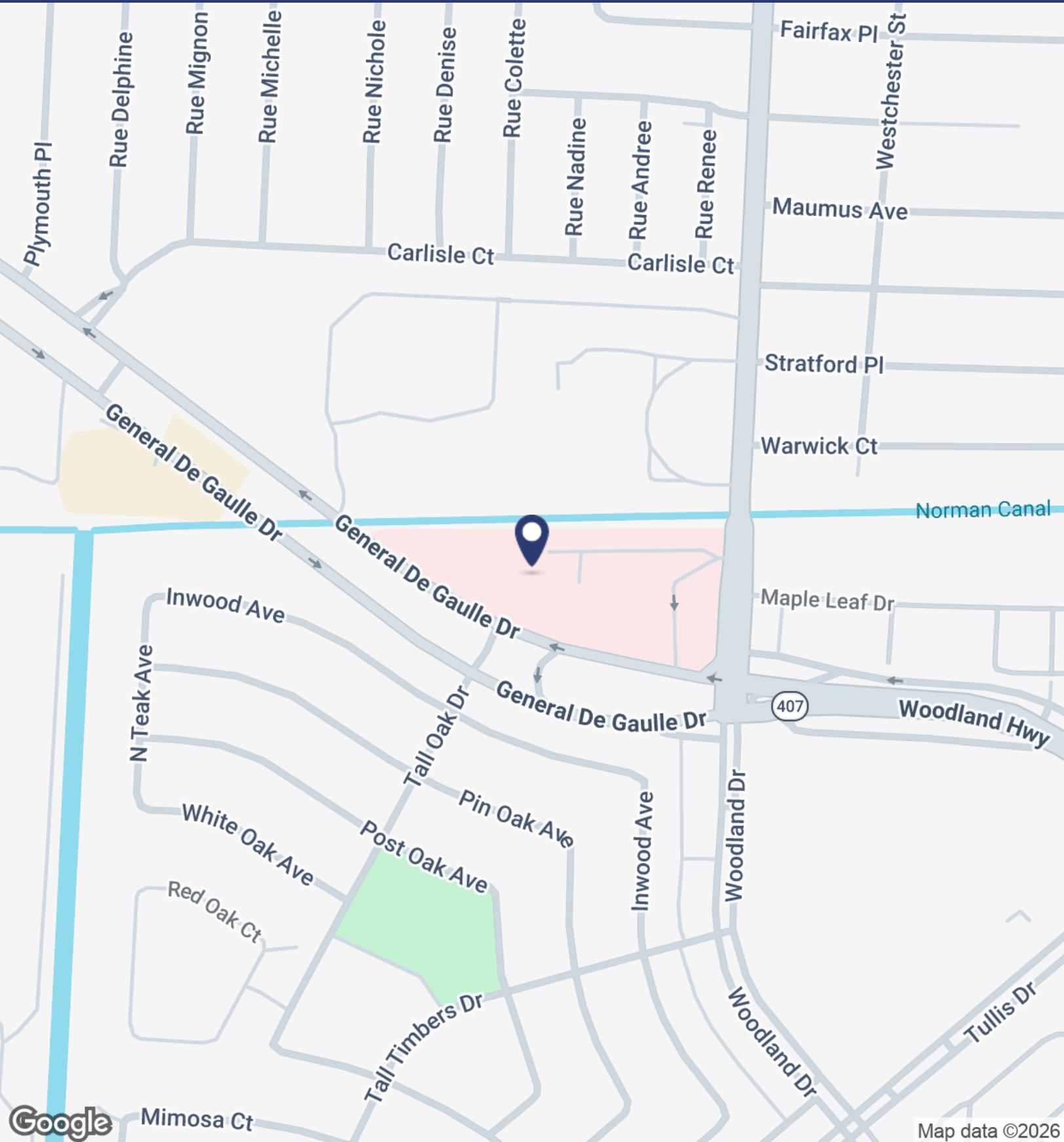

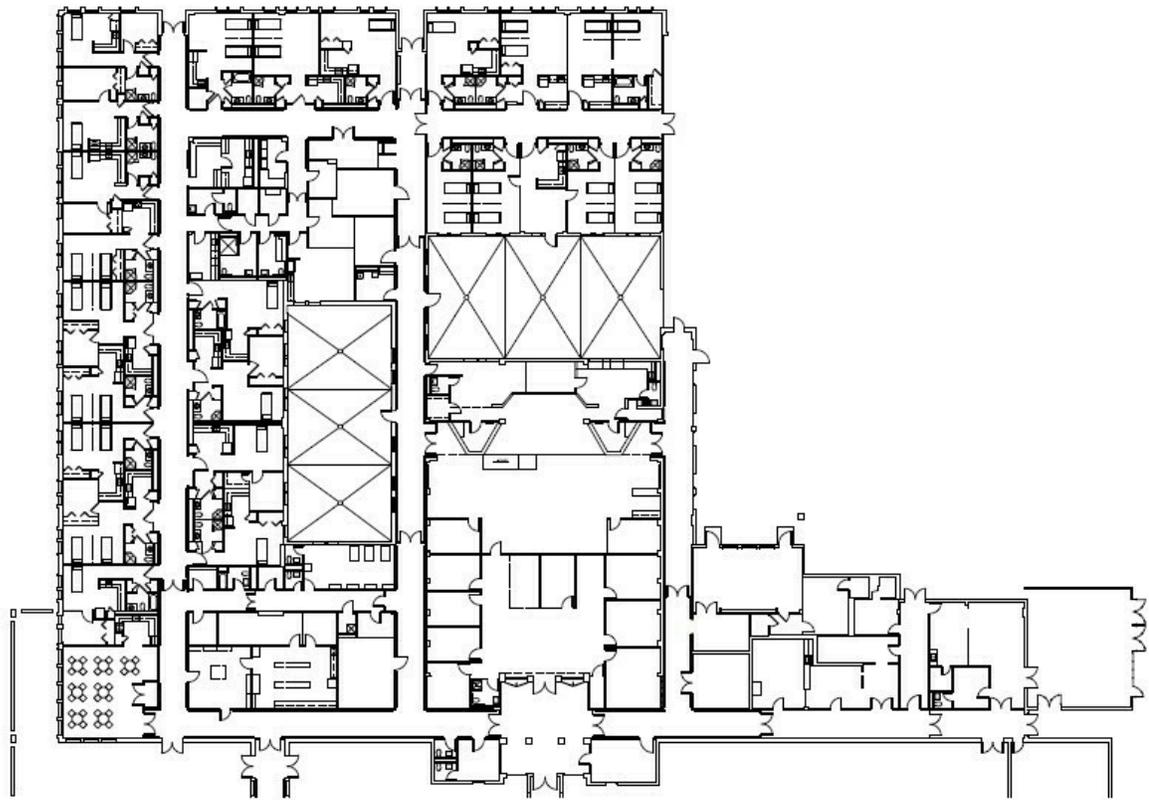

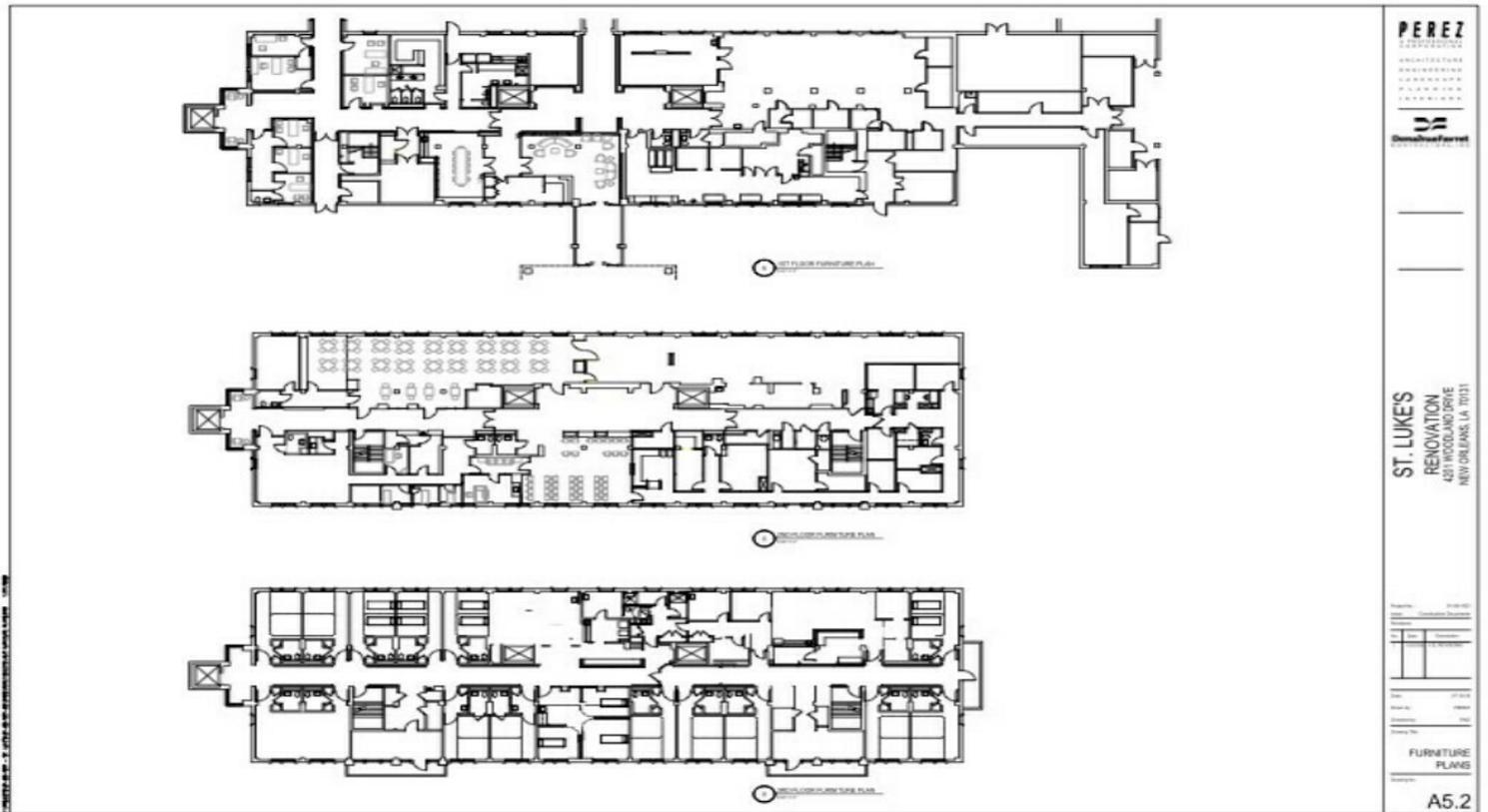

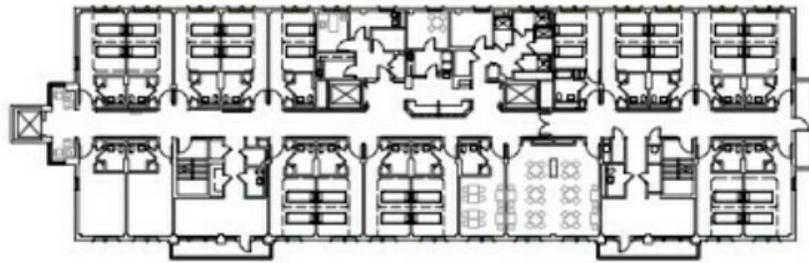

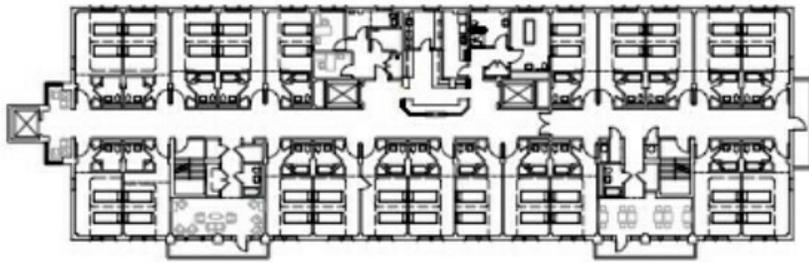

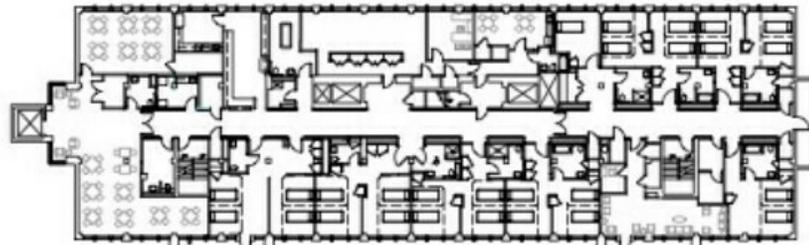

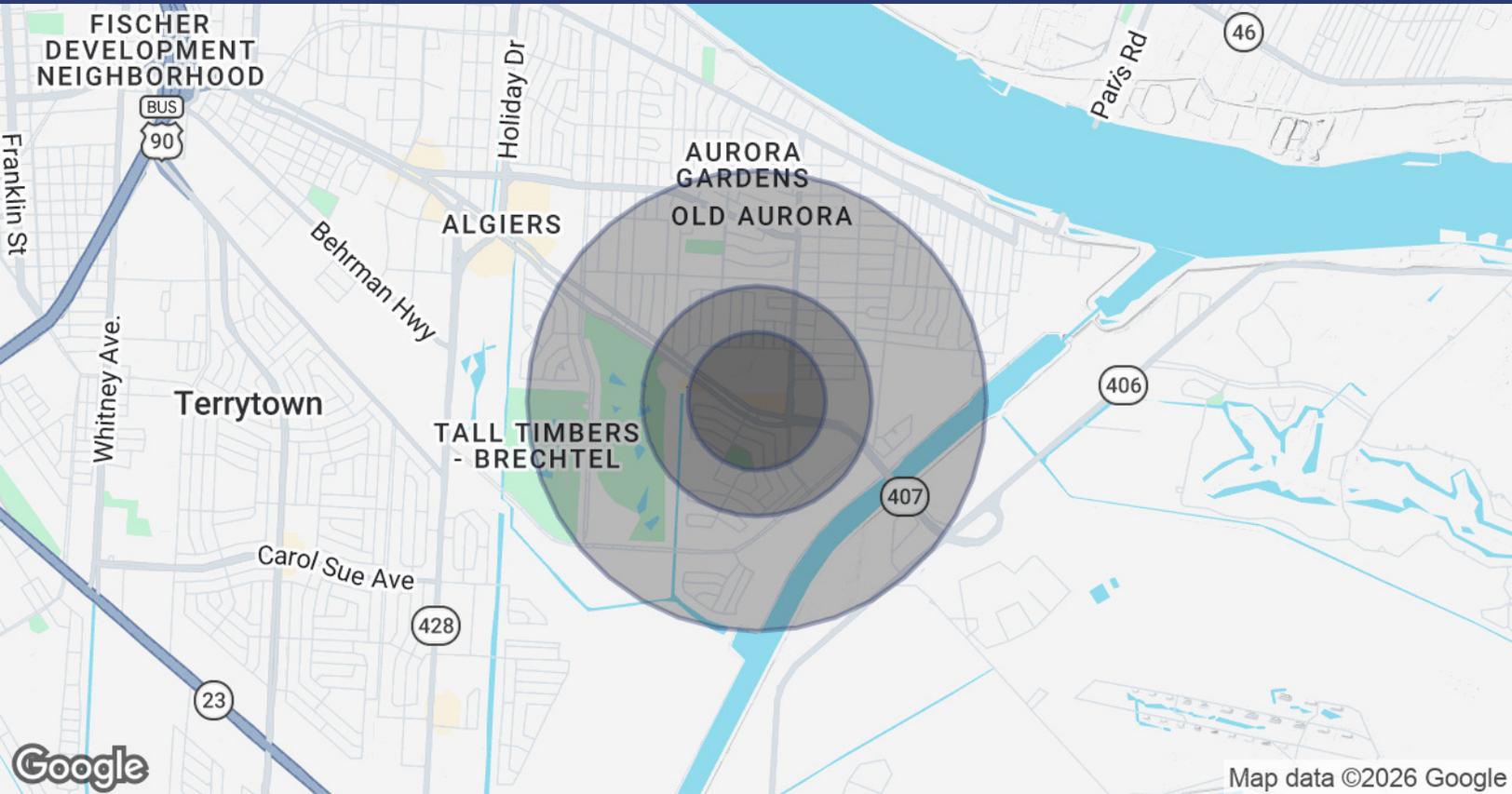

## Customer Information Form

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What Customers Need to Know When Working with Real Estate Brokers or Licensees

*This document describes the various types of agency relationships that can exist in real estate transactions.*

**AGENCY** means a relationship in which a real estate broker or licensee represents a client by the client's consent, whether expressed or implied, in an immovable property transaction. An agency relationship is formed when a real estate licensee works for you in your best interest and represents you. Agency relationships can be formed with buyers/sellers and lessors/lessees.

**DESIGNATED AGENCY** means the agency relationship that shall be presumed to exist when a licensee engaged in any real estate transaction, except as otherwise provided in LA R.S. 9:3891, is working with a client, unless there is a written agreement providing for a different relationship.

- The law presumes that the real estate licensee you work with is your designated agent, unless you have a written agreement otherwise.
- No other licensees in the office work for you, unless disclosed and approved by you.
- You should confine your discussions of buying/selling to your designated agent or agents only.

**DUAL AGENCY** means an agency relationship in which a licensee is working with both buyer and seller or both landlord and tenant in the same transaction. Such a relationship shall not constitute dual agency if the licensee is the seller of property that he/she owns or if the property is owned by a real estate business of which the licensee is the sole proprietor and agent. A dual agency relationship shall not be construed to exist in a circumstance in which the licensee is working with both landlord and tenant as to a lease that does not exceed a term of three years and the licensee is the landlord. Dual agency is allowed only when informed consent is presumed to have been given by any client who signed the dual agency disclosure form prescribed by the Louisiana Real Estate Commission. Specific duties owed to both buyer/seller and lessor/lessee are:

- To treat all clients honestly.
- To provide factual information about the property.
- To disclose all latent material defects in the property that are known to them.
- To help the buyer compare financing options.
- To provide information about comparable properties that have sold, so that both clients may make educated buying/selling decisions.

- To disclose financial qualifications to the buyer/lessee to the seller/lessor.
- To explain real estate terms.
- To help buyers/lessees arrange for property inspections
- To explain closing costs and procedures.

**CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION** means information obtained by a licensee from a client during the term of a brokerage agreement that was made confidential by the written request or written instruction of the client or is information the disclosure of which could materially harm the position of the client, unless at any time any of the following occur:

- The client permits the disclosure by word or conduct.
- The disclosure is required by law or would reveal serious defect.
- The information became public from a source other than the licensee.
