


ABOUT THE PROPERTY

This rare opportunity for redevelopment in The Cass Corridor offers a variety of possibilities! They include new construction on vacant parcels with a rehab of existing the structure; uses could include subsidized housing with servicing center, co-working space, medical offices, condo conversion, or a family office center. There is plenty of space for parking and expansion, as well. Built in 1888, the schoolhouse was designed by J.B. Tarleton, who served as the architect for the Detroit Board of Education from 1884 to 1890. This is the only school he designed that is still standing. The building served as an elementary school until 1923. Through 1981, the building remained a center for education and wellness before it was converted into office space. This is the oldest school building in the city of Detroit, and was listed on the National Register of Historic Places and designated a Michigan State Historic Site in 1982.








































