LOCATION DESCRIPTION


EDWARDS AREA

Edwards is home to approximately 11,000 residents and located in the heart of the Vail Valley. In 2020, the median household income in Edwards was \$68,898, compared to \$64,994 nationally, according to the US Census Bureau. According to the Zillow Home Value index, the typical value of a home in Edwards is \$1,845,542, compared to \$354,165 nationally.

With a wide variety of boutiques, lodging options, movie theaters, restaurants, professional services, and activities, Edwards is a popular location for visitors and locals year-round. It is the largest community in Eagle County and home to many of the areas educational facilities including Battle Mountain High School, Berry Creek Middle School, and Colorado Mountain College.


Edwards is also home to several exclusive residential communities including Arrowhead, Cordillera, and Singletree.
