Downtown San Diego continues to experience rapid growth, with new developments, residential towers, and innovative businesses transforming the urban landscape into a vibrant hub for living, working, and entertainment.



THE GROWTH

Residential development along San Diego's Fourth, Fifth, and Sixth Avenue corridors is set to expand with a mix of high-rise and mid-rise buildings, while single-family neighborhoods and canyon areas will remain largely unchanged. New development will prioritize affordable housing over the next 20 years.

By 2037, self-driving cars and ride-sharing services like Uber are expected to reduce the need for parking lots, which could be repurposed for residential or green spaces. There is also potential for more light rail and streetcars, with pedestrian and bicycle infrastructure becoming a key focus for future urban planning.


By modernizing the facility, San Diego will further solidify its position as a top-tier destination for large-scale conventions and gatherings, boosting tourism and the local economy.
