PROPERTY OVERVIEW

1204 Copperfield Parkway is a ±25,000-square-foot single-story building located in the Copperfield Business Park in College Station, Texas. The property offers a flexible floor plan with high-quality existing finishes. It is easily accessible to College Station, Bryan, and Texas A&M University via University Drive and is in close proximity to both major north-south corridors. The building has an oversized parking lot.

AREA OVERVIEW



College Station is a city located in Brazos County, Texas. Situated in the east-central part of the state (90 miles northwest of Houston and 87 miles northeast of Austin), College Station is the commercial and cultural hub of the seven-county Brazos Valley region. This area is also framed by the Texas Triangle—the emerging urban mega-region including Houston, Dallas-Fort Worth, Austin, and San Antonio. The Texas Triangle features over 19 million residents, \$1.3 trillion of GDP (2018 estimate), and over 50 Fortune 500 headquarters. The 2020 census recorded 120,511 residents in College Station.

It and the city of Bryan constitute the Bryan-College Station MSA, the fifteenth-largest metropolitan area in Texas.

College Station is home to the main campus of Texas A&M University, the flagship institution of the Texas A&M University System. The city owes its name and incorporation to the University's location along the Union Pacific railroad. Texas A&M is a public, R1 (tier-one) research institution and one of only 17 land-, sea-, and space-grant universities in the United States. It is currently the largest university in the country (by enrollment). Texas A&M brings a broad scope of research endeavors to the region with ongoing projects funded through agencies including NASA, the National Institutes for Health, the National Science Foundation, and the US Department of Energy.

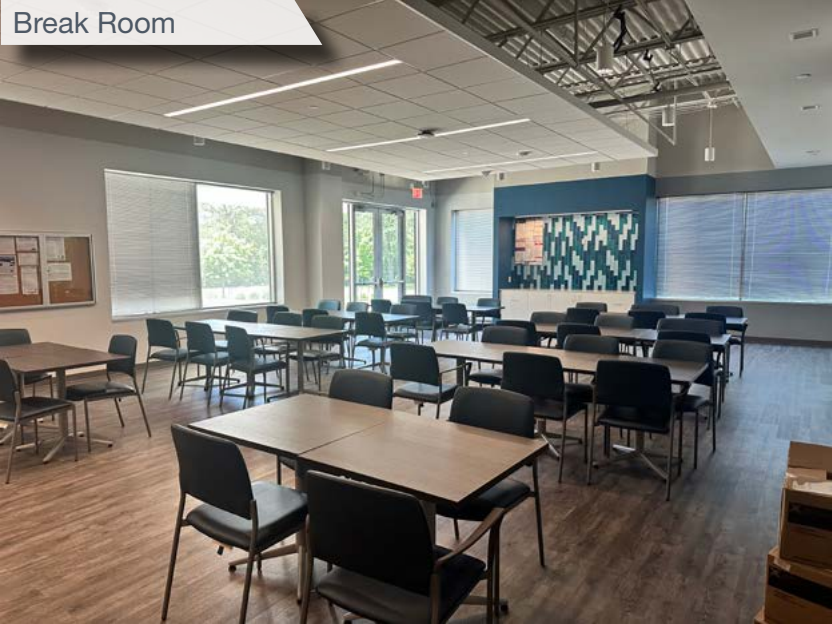

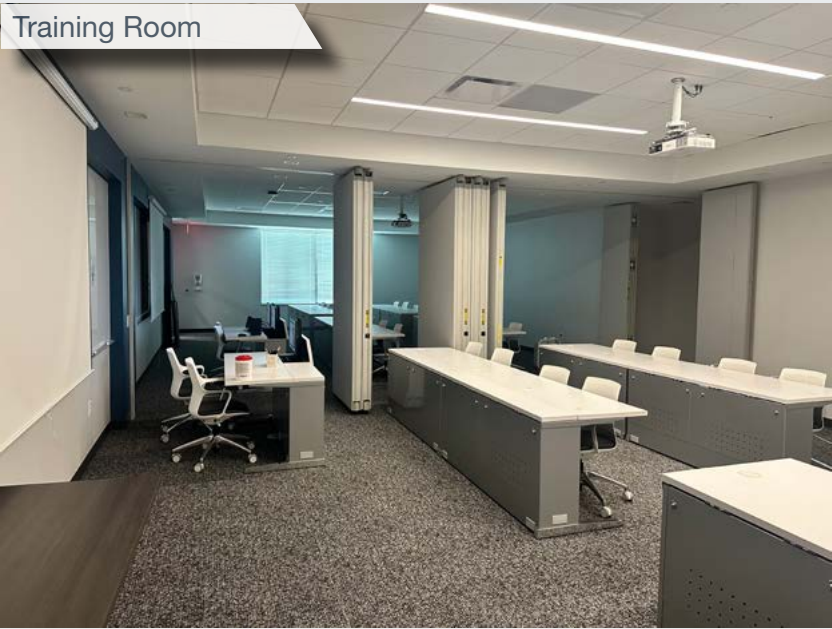

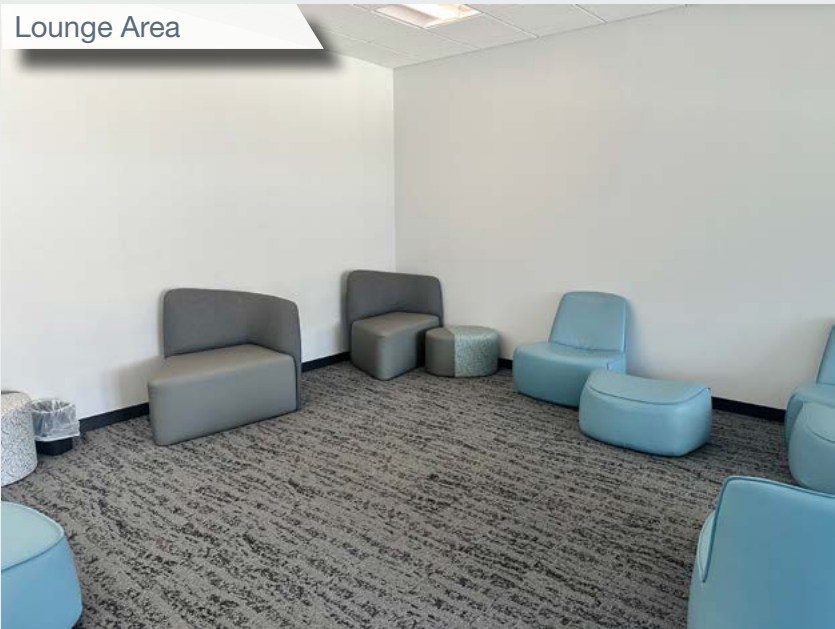

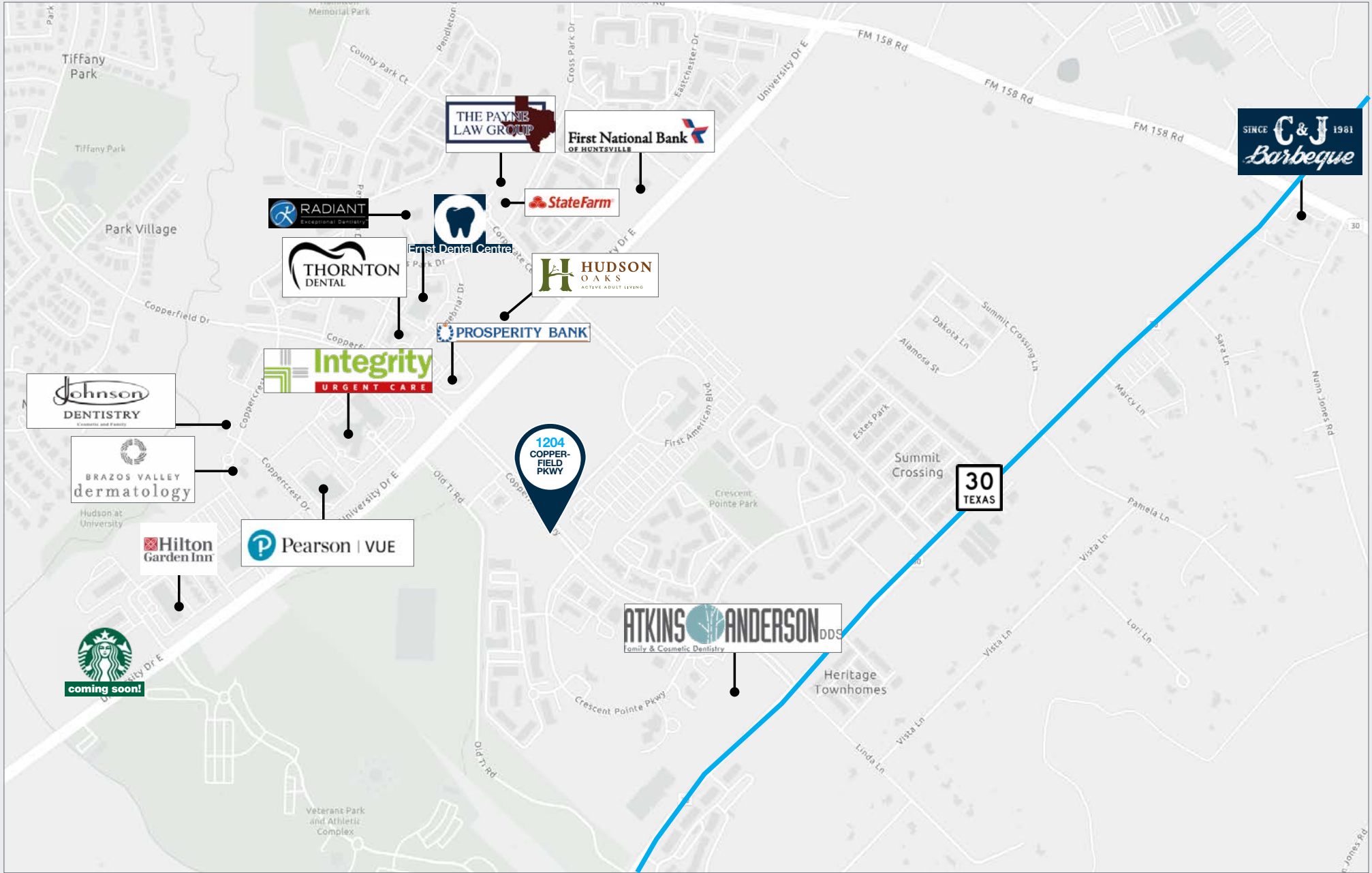
