The five-year projection for the population in the area is 46,839 representing a change of 1.85% annually from 2020 to 2025. Currently, the population is 48.4% male and 51.6% female.

The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 58.5 in the identified area, compared to 65.1 for the U.S. as a whole.

Current average household income is \$113,555 in this area, compared to \$90,054 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$126,446 in five years, compared to \$99,510 for all U.S. households

Current per capita income is \$37,185 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$34,136. The per capita income is projected to be \$41,356 in five years, compared to \$37,691 for all U.S. households

Currently, 80.2% of the 14,307 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 17.3%, renter occupied; and 2.5% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.3% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 11,962 housing units in the area - 78.9% owner occupied, 15.8% renter occupied, and 5.4% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 8.28%. Median home value in the area is \$335,002, compared to a median home value of \$235,127 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 0.70% annually to \$346,872.
