




BRAND EXPANSION

Moe's Southwest Grill, fondly known as Moe's, is a lively fast-casual Southwestern restaurant chain founded in Atlanta, Georgia, in December 2000, with franchising beginning around 2001. Its name stands for "Musicians, Outlaws and Entertainers," paying homage to artists and pop-culture with music-themed décor. Today Moe's is part of the GoTo Foods family. The brand now boasts around 580-650 U.S. locations as of early 2025 and celebrated its 25th anniversary with continued growth, innovation in loyalty programs, remodeling efforts, and strong franchise development. In Worcester, Moe's operates at 3 Stafford Street.
