




Randolph Office Center











Typical 6,000 SF floor plan



Combined 12,000 SF floor plan (spans both buildings)





Randolph Office Center


About the West Loop

This ultra-urban, former warehouse district is one of Chicago's hip, up-and-coming neighborhoods, just steps away from Loop. Even though it had its start as an industrial storage center, the West Loop is making up for lost time by infusing the area with as much active life and entertainment options as space will allow. In fact, West Loop's Union Park is more than a playground - it doubles as an annual outdoor festival venue for the popular Pitchfork Music Festival each year. 
