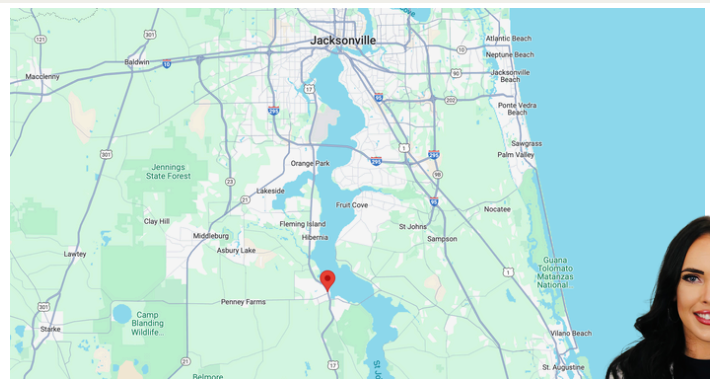

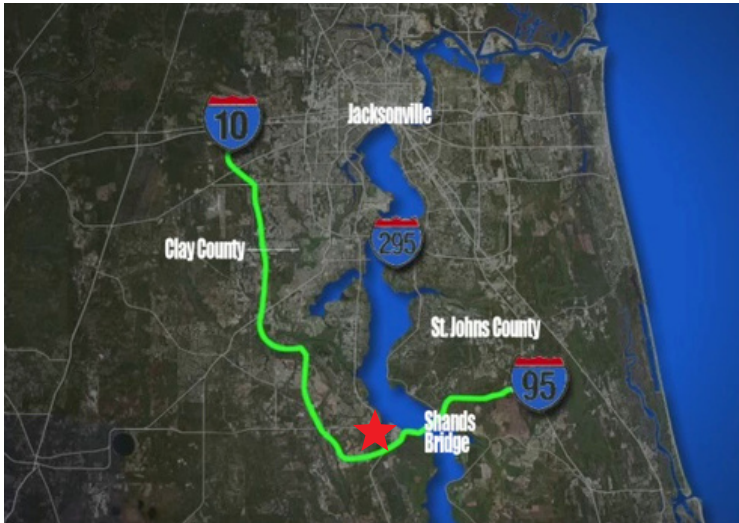

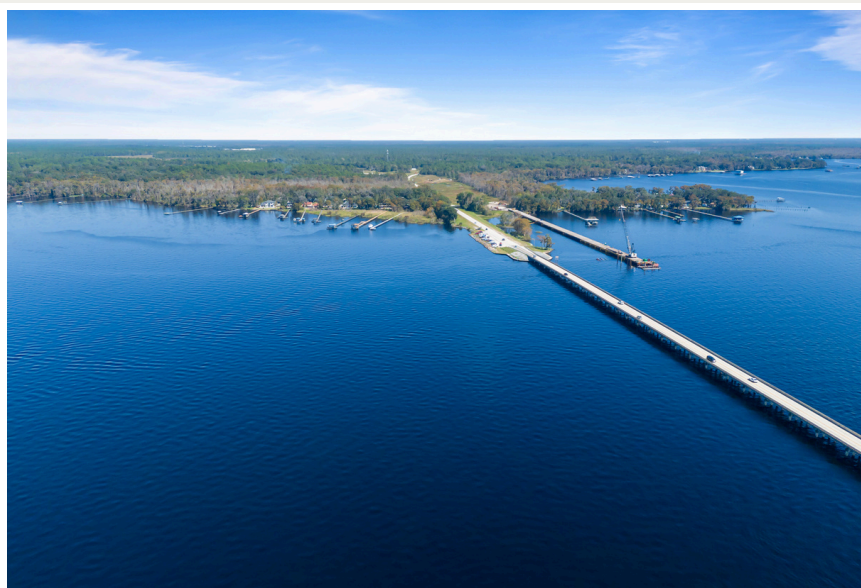

First Coast Expressway

The First Coast Expressway runs through the heart of Clay County to connect I-10 in Duval County to I-95 in St. Johns County. The 46 mile four-lane divided toll road will include 7 new interchanges in Clay County (13 project total) with traffic flowing through electronic toll gantries without stops.





New First Coast Expressway bridge under construction over the St. Johns River just south of where the Shands Bridge stands currently. The vertical height clearance of the new bridge will be 65 feet. The additional 20 feet of clearance will match the Buckman Bridge's clearance to the north removing all barriers for marine traffic.
