3.2.4. RSF-2: Residential Single Family 2 District

(a) Purpose

The purpose of the RSF-2: Residential Single Family 2 District is to provide lands that accommodate low-density single-family detached dwellings on lots with a minimum lot area of 7,500 square feet. The district also accommodates certain group living arrangements as conditional uses, accessory uses such as home occupations and home-based child care, and other compatible uses. District regulations discourage development that negatively impacts the quiet residential nature of the district.







(b) Use Standards

Allowed uses and use-specific standards for principal, accessory, and temporary uses are established in Article 4: Use Regulations.
