





LOCAL NEWS AND DEVELOPMENT

COLUMBUS, GA

Columbus, located in Western Georgia, is the second-largest city in the state. the city has a population of **over 200,000 people, and approximately 315,000 in its metro area**. the city is typically divided into 5 geographic areas: downtown, east Columbus, Midtown, north Columbus, and south Columbus. Columbus is known for being an excellent place to live, thanks to its high quality of life, low cost of living, and friendly residents. the city is also a large tourist location in the south due to its many attractions.





Columbus is home to a number of businesses, including several notable corporate headquarters. Aflac, Carmike Cinemas, TSYS, Realtree, Synovus, and the W.C. Bradley Co. all are headquartered in the city.

Columbus offers a wide array of entertainment for visitors and residents to enjoy. Indoor entertainment includes museums, dining, shopping, and theaters. some of the most popular sights in the city are the Coca-Cola space science Center, the Columbus Museum, and the riverCenter for the Performing arts. due to Columbus's location next to the Chattahoochee river, there are an abundance of activities available to outdoor enthusiasts. The Chattahoochee riverwalk is a linear park that wraps around the banks of the river, which has been named the world's best manmade whitewater course by USAToday.



FORT MOORE

Fort Benning is a United States Army post straddling the Alabama—Georgia border next to Columbus, Georgia. Fort Benning supports more than 120,000 activeduty military, family members, reserve component soldiers, retirees and civilian employees on a daily basis, it is a true military community.

There are 4,000 homes on post that stay full year round with waiting lists.

Fort Benning has graduation ceremonies nearly every Thursday and Friday mornings of the year. These ceremonies take place adjacent to the National Infantry Museum which is just down the street from Heritage Corners Shopping Center.

Fort Benning population has the following: 12,816 Military (Permanent Active Duty); 19,912 Military Trainees (weekly average); 26,900 Family Members; and 3,745 Civilian Workers.

Fort Benning is the 6th largest installation and 3rd largest troop density.
