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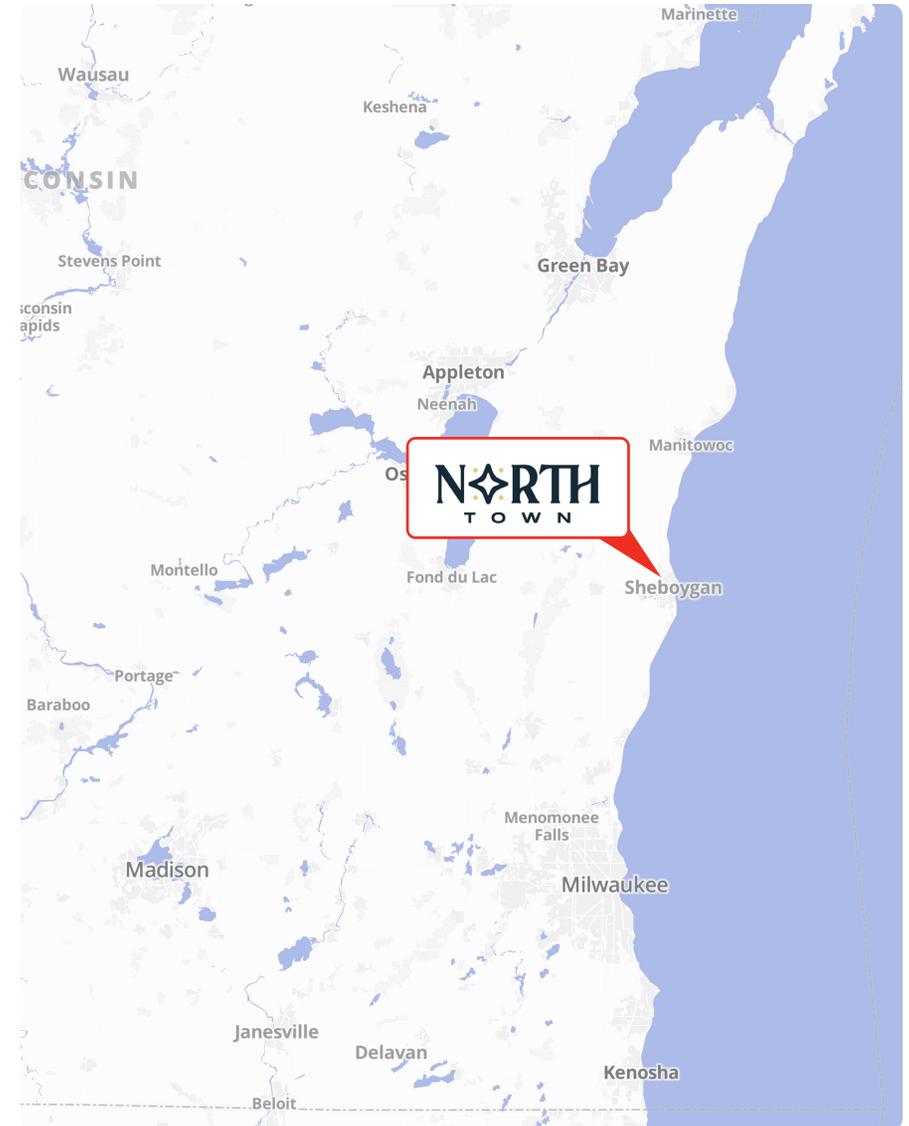
# Development Overview

North Town | Sheboygan, WI



North Town is a 99-acre mixed-use development in the Town of Sheboygan, ideally situated just northeast of the I-43 and Highway 42 interchange. Designed as a connected “front-porch” community, North Town blends residential neighborhoods, retail, hospitality, and green space into a walkable, modern environment. With full infrastructure in place and strong municipal support, it offers immediate accessibility and exceptional visibility — drawing more than 35,000 vehicles per day along I-43. This strategic location provides seamless access to the Sheboygan metro area while maintaining a neighborhood atmosphere that emphasizes convenience, livability, and lasting value.

Available lots range from approximately 0.5 to 13 acres and are fully flexible for retail, office, or hospitality uses under the site’s Planned Unit Development zoning. Each parcel is shovel-ready, with utilities and road access in place, making it ideal for quick development. Surrounded by successful neighboring projects — including a hotel, senior living, and multifamily housing — North Town presents a prime opportunity for investors and businesses seeking growth in a high-visibility corridor.

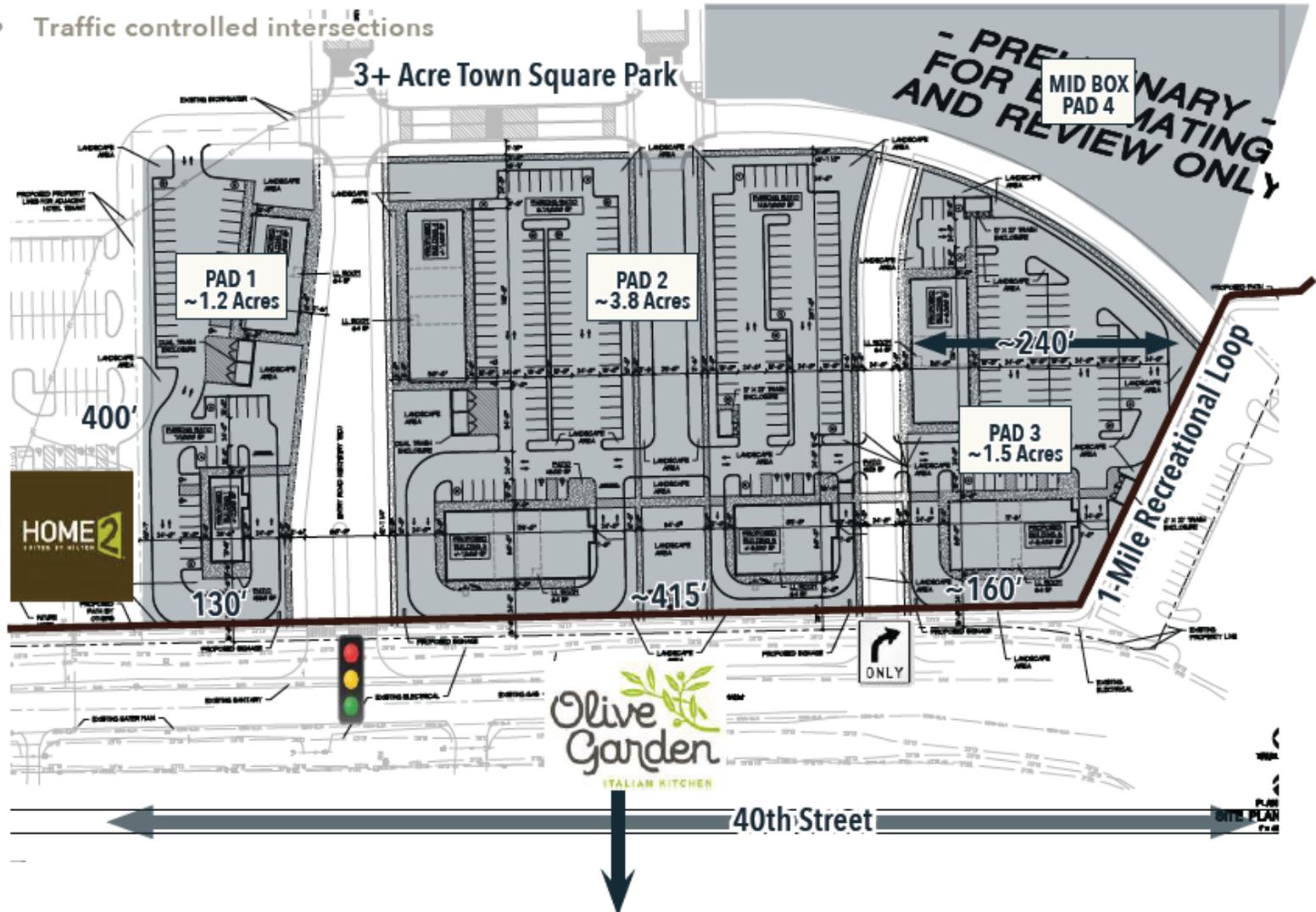


# Site Plan

- The duty, when negotiating, to present contract proposals in an objective and unbiased manner and disclose the advantages and disadvantages of the proposals.

A "Material Adverse Fact" is defined in Wis. Stat 452.01 (5g) as an Adverse Fact that a party indicates is of such significance, or that is generally recognized by a competent licensee as being of such significance to a reasonable party, that it affects or would affect the party's decision to enter into a contract or agreement concerning a transaction or affects or would affect the party's decision about the terms of such a contract or agreement.

An "Adverse" fact is defined in Wis. Stat. 452.01 (1e) as a condition or occurrence that a competent licensee generally recognizes will significantly and adversely affect the value of the property, significantly reduce the structural integrity of improvements to real estate, or present a significant health risk to occupants of the property; or information that indicates that a party to a transaction is not able to or does not intend to meet his or her obligations under a contract or agreement made concerning the transaction.
