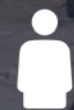

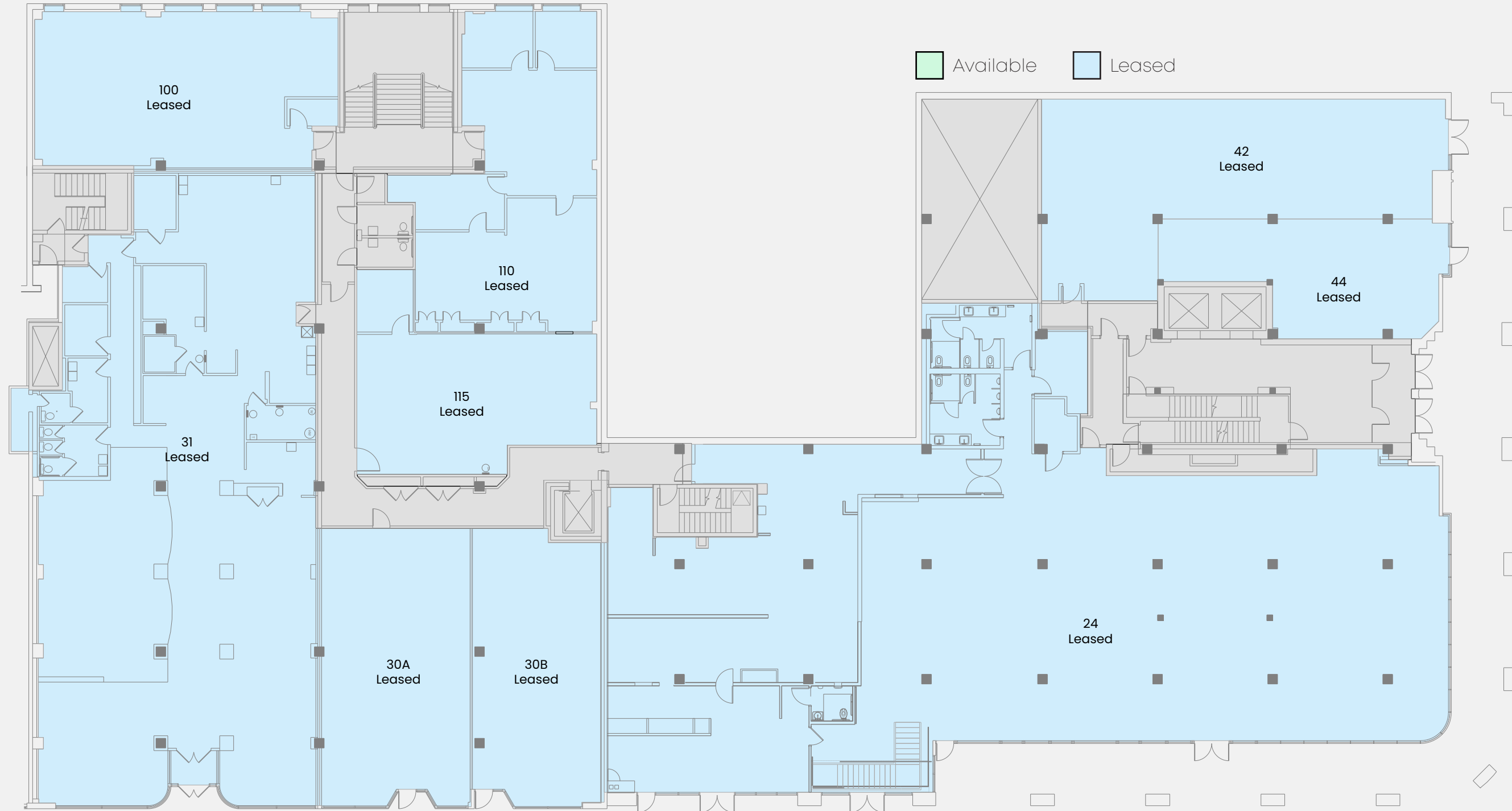

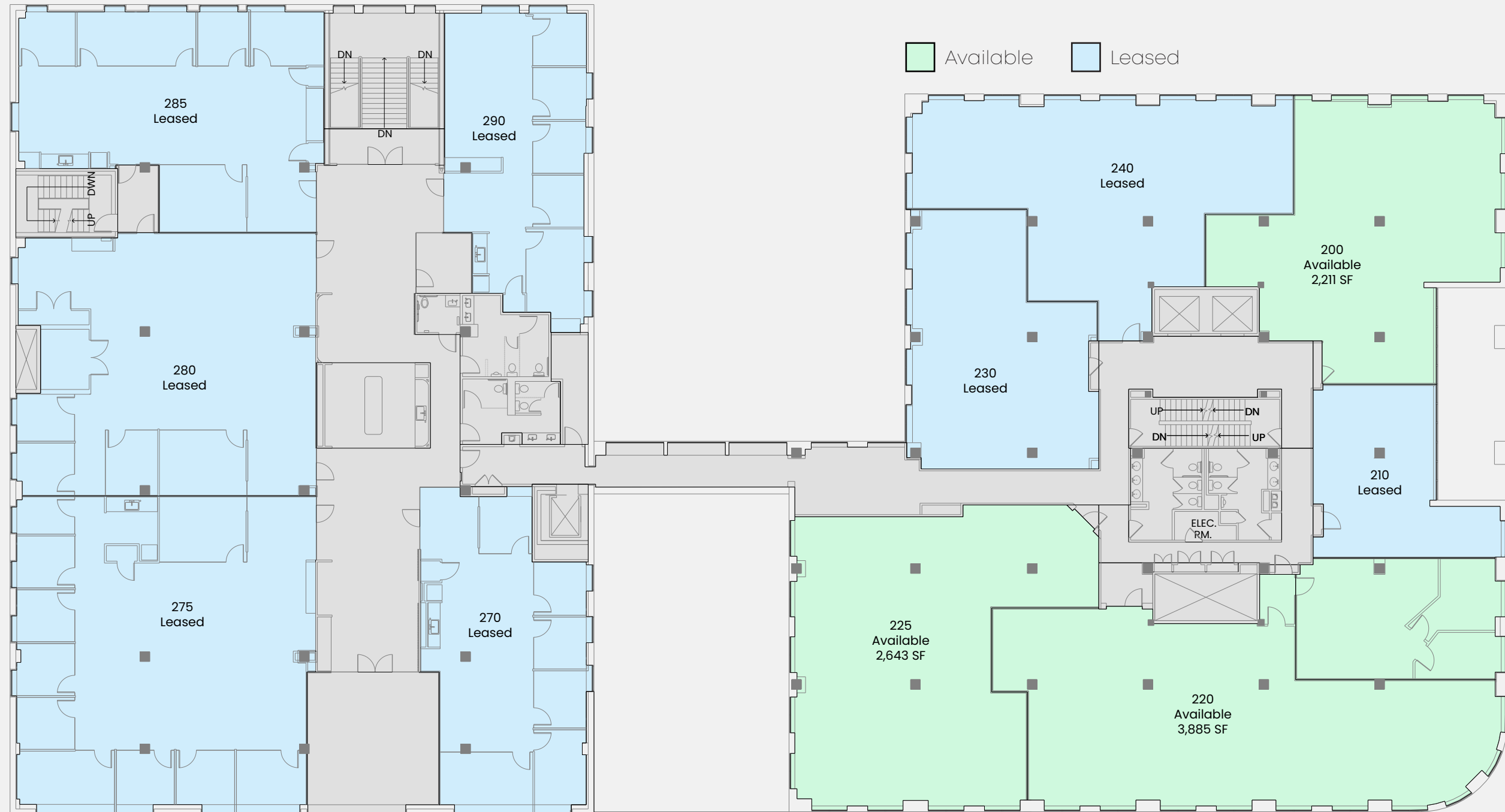
Lower Level Floor Plan



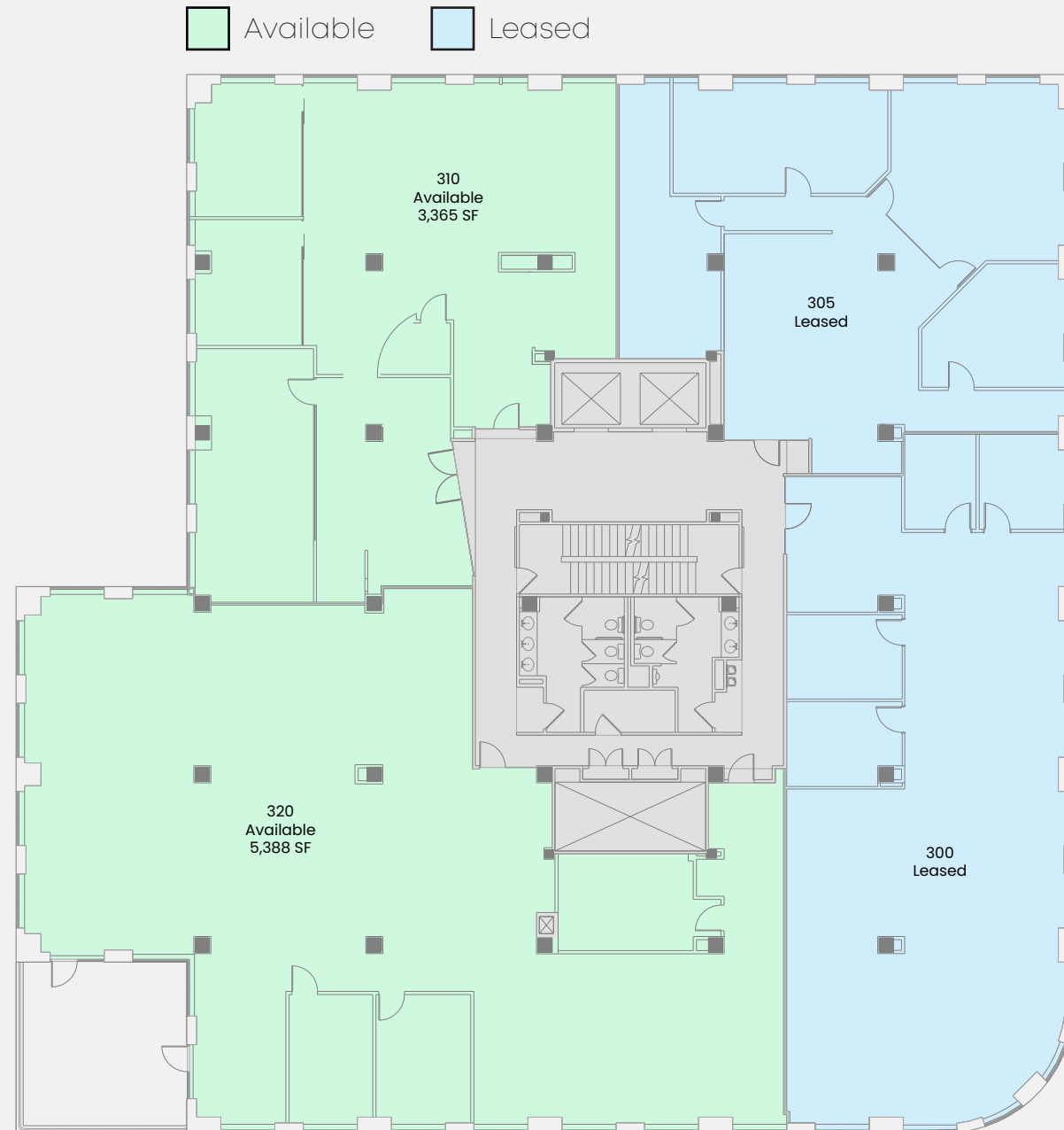
1st Floor Plan

3rd Floor Plan

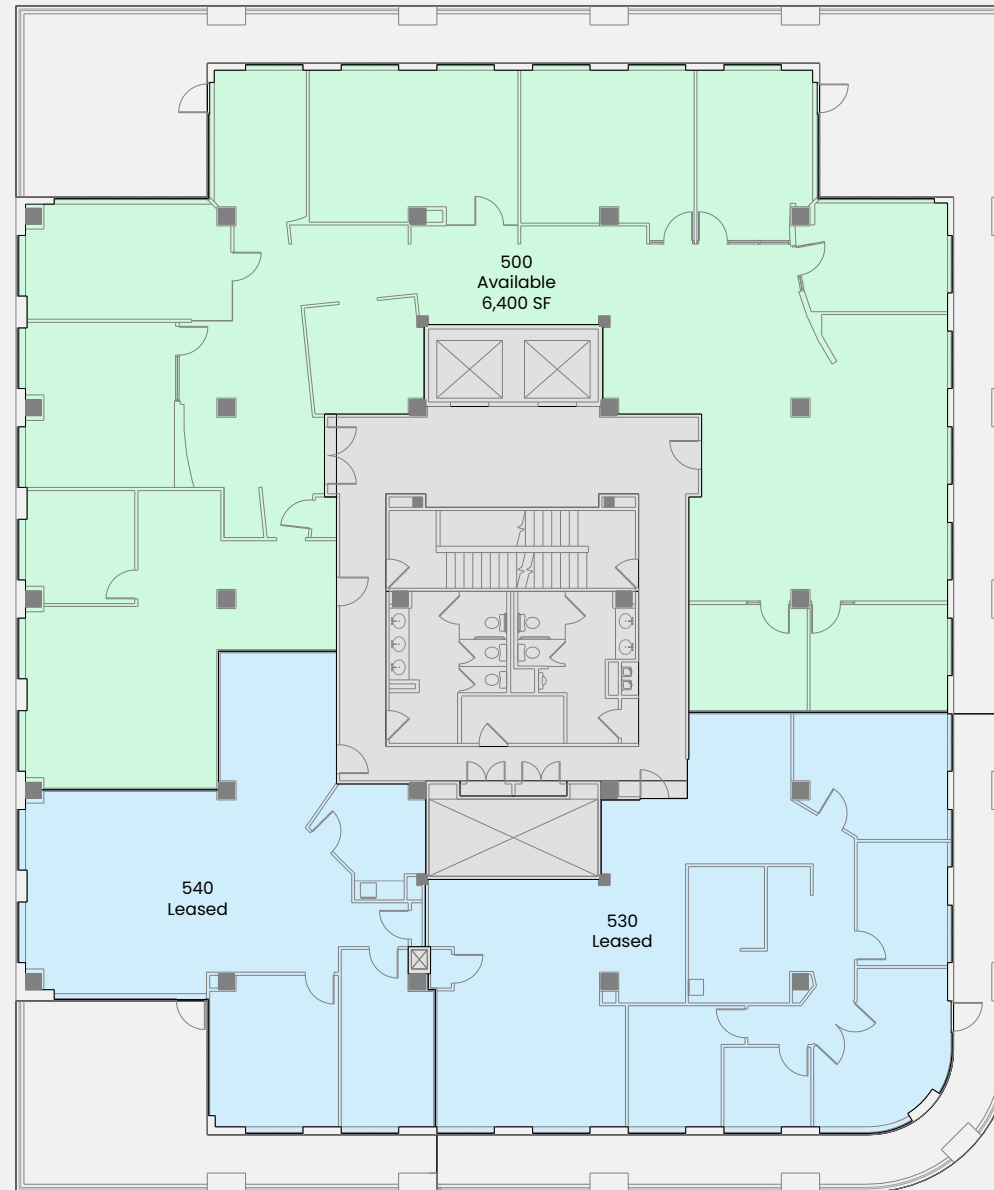


4th Floor Plan
