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INTRODUCTION



There are places on Lake Muskoka where the landscape feels untouched by time — where the shoreline curves gently around quiet water, where the pines rise like cathedral columns, and where the land holds a sense of permanence that is increasingly rare. This estate property is one of those places.

Set along the sheltered side of Mortimer's Point, this remarkable 46-acre waterfront holding is defined by scale, privacy, and an unspoiled natural character that evokes the earliest traditions of Muskoka. Eight hundred feet (MPAC) of combined frontage trace the edge of a calm, protected bay, offering warm, quiet waters and long, uninterrupted sightlines across the bay. The experience here is intimate and expansive at once, a private world shaped by forest, granite, and sky. The land unfolds in a series of natural terraces and ridges, each offering its own perspective on the water. Mature pines tower overhead, granite outcrops anchor the shoreline, and soft clearings open to the lake in a way that invites thoughtful architecture and inspired design.

It is a landscape that welcomes vision, whether for a signature estate residence, a multi-generational family retreat, or a long-term legacy property to be stewarded for decades.

Comprising three separately parcels deeded by Queen Victoria, this is Muskoka at its most authentic, quiet mornings on the dock, the scent of pine warmed by the sun, the stillness of a sheltered bay, and the sense of arriving somewhere meaningful. This estate property is not simply a property; it is a setting for legacy, a canvas for architecture, and one of the last remaining opportunities to secure a landholding of true significance on Lake Muskoka.

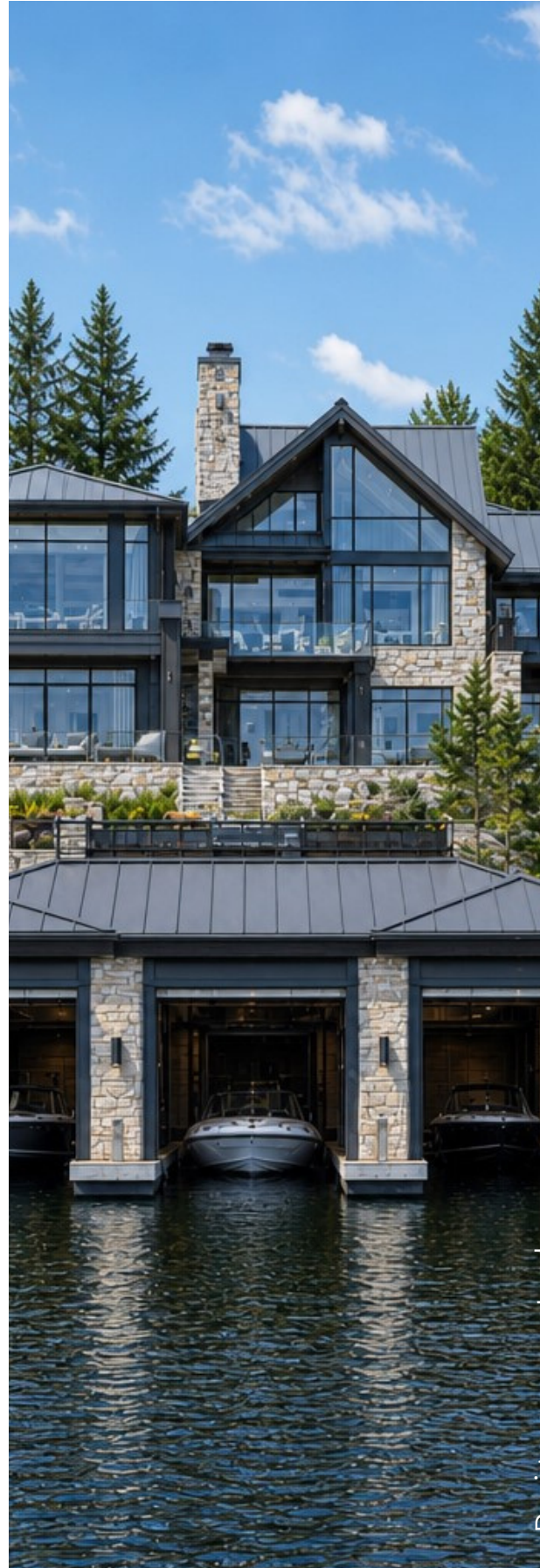
