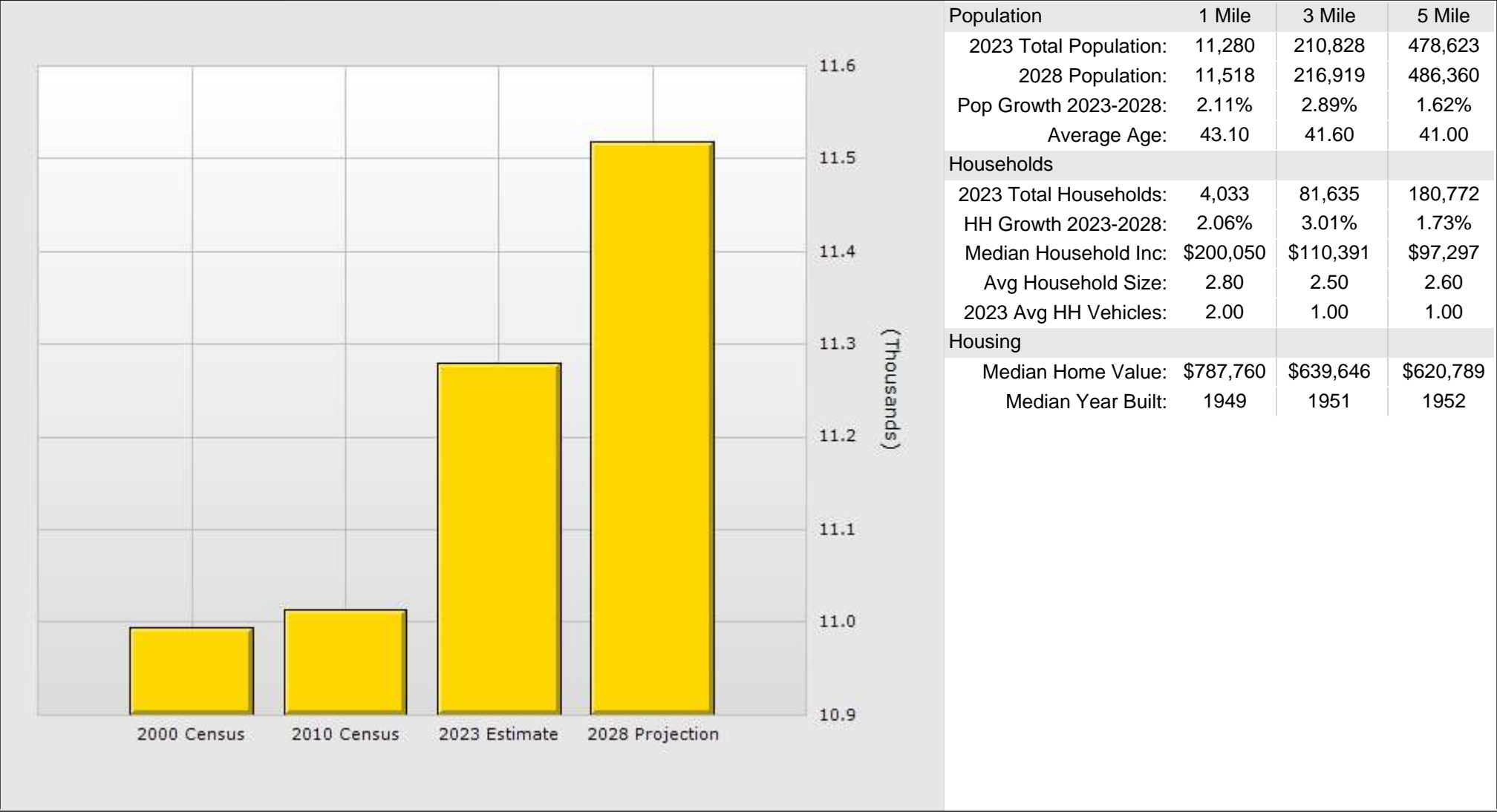

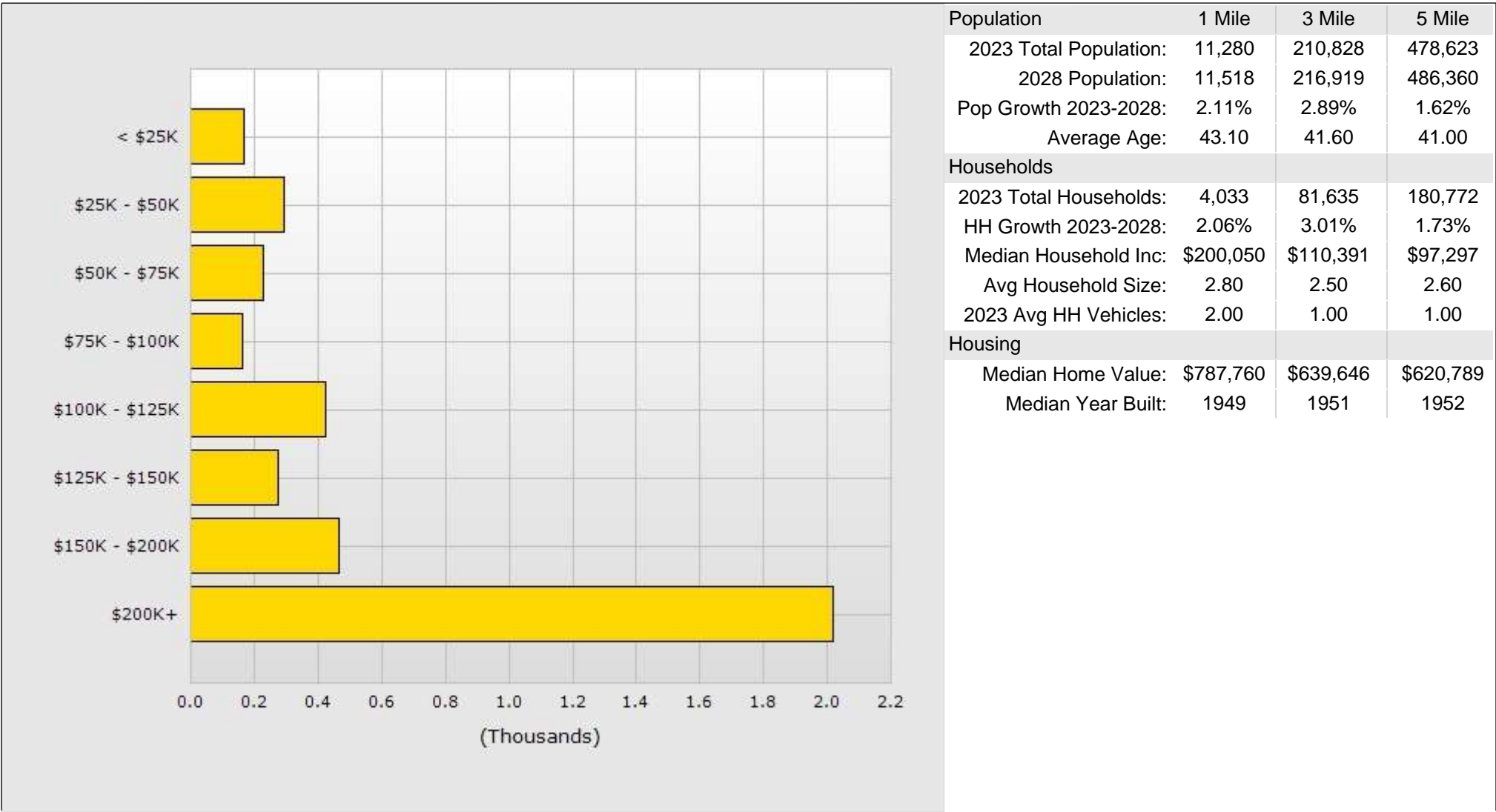
# Population for 1 Mile Radius

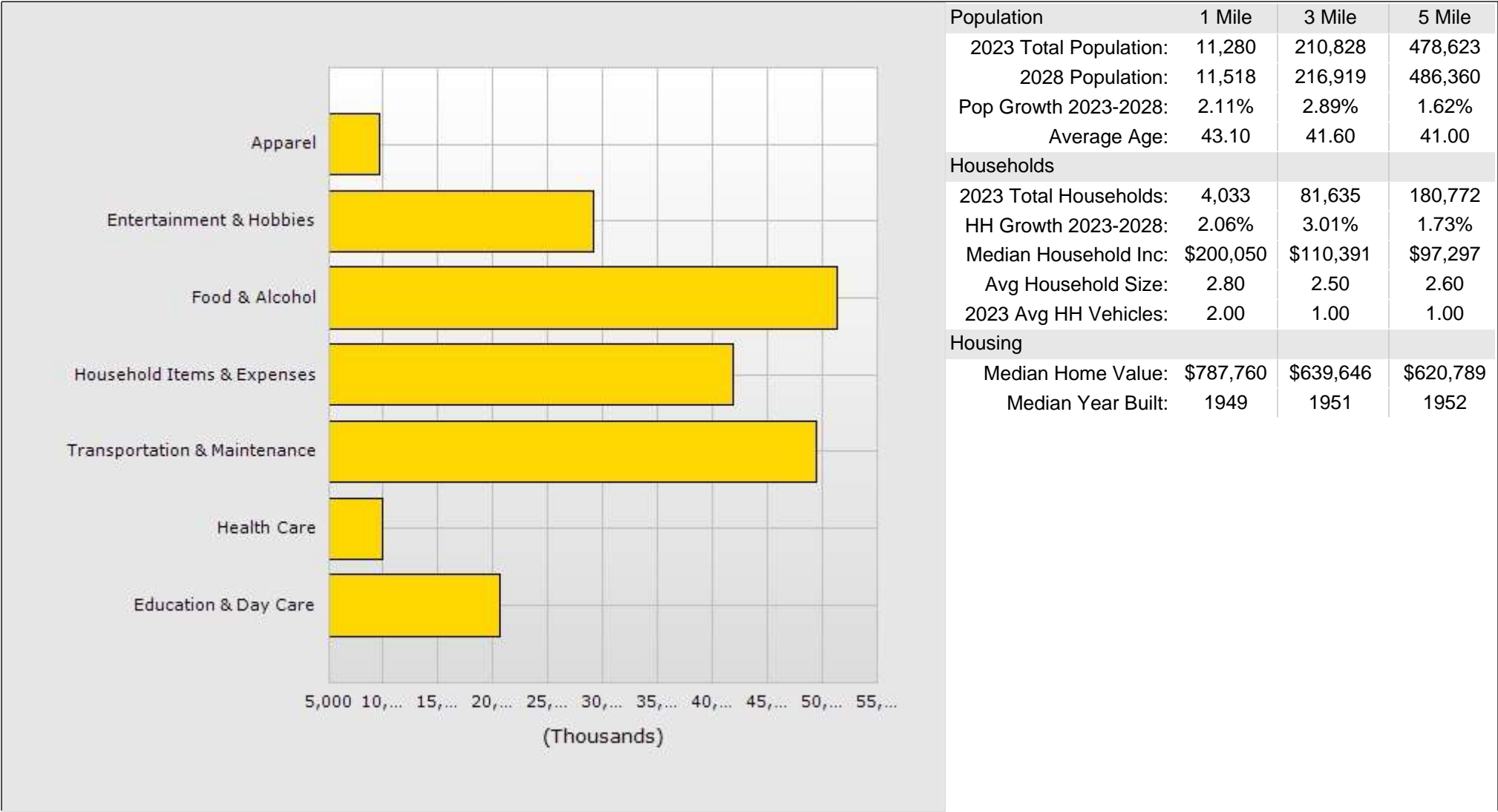
# Households by Income for 1 Mile Radius
