The Development Authority of Polk County (DAPC) has been working with SOLARCYLE, an advanced technology-based solar recycling company in their expansion and purchase of 270 North Park Blvd, Cedartown GA (previous Gildan building) located in Cedartown North Business Park. This investment will enable them to accelerate their recycling capacity to the solar glass manufacturing facility across the road that will begin construction in 2025. This will be an additional \$62 million capital investment and an additional 640 new full-time jobs.

As a recap from SOLARCYLE's announcement in February, this will put SOLARCYCLE's total capital investment over \$400 million and total job creation at 1,257 when they are operating at full capacity. What a GREAT win for this community!!
