# DELINEATING FRESHWATER WETLANDS LETTER OF INTERPRETATION (LOI)



#### **Definition:**

"LOI" is a document issued by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) under NJAC 7:7A-4, indicating the presence or absence of wetlands, State open waters, or transition areas; verifying or delineating the boundaries of freshwater wetlands, State open waters, and/or transition areas; or assigning a wetland a resource value classification.

### NJDEP issues the following five (5) types of LOIs:

<u>Presence/Absence</u> – Identifies whether any freshwater wetlands, State open water or transitions area exist on a site. A Presence/Absence does not identify the boundaries of any wetlands, State open water or associated transitional areas. A Presence/Absence can be issued for any site, regardless of size.

<u>Presence/Absence – Footprint of Disturbance</u> – Identifies whether any freshwater wetlands or State open water exist within a defined "footprint" on a subject site or whether a transition area from an adjacent wetland is within the footprint.

- The footprint area must be no larger than one acre.
- The Department will issue a FOD for more than one portion of a site, provided that:
  - o Each portion is no larger than one acre;
  - o The applicant submits a separate fee for each portion; and
  - o No more than three presence/absence LOIs shall be issued for a single site under this subsection.

<u>Wetland Delineation – Line Delineation</u> – Identifies the boundaries of any freshwater wetland, transition areas, and/ or State open waters on a site of municipal tax lot that is one acre or smaller.

<u>Line Verification</u> – Identifies the boundary lines of freshwater wetlands, transition areas, and/or State open waters on a site, regardless of its size, or a municipal tax lot no larger than the site, and the resource value classification of any freshwater wetlands. The applicant must submit a proposed delineation of wetlands, transition areas, and/or State open waters, which the Department will confirm or modify.

<u>Line Verification</u> – Partial – Identifies the boundary lines of freshwater wetlands, transition areas, and/or State open waters on a portion of the site. All of the following criteria must be met

- · The site is publicly owned;
- The site is larger than 10 acres;
- The portion that is to be verified is no larger than 10 percent of the overall site; and
- The portion is clearly marked on the plan and on the ground.

Completeness Review – 20 days LOI Issuance – 3-5 months Life of Approval – 5 years
