

The city of Whitesboro was founded by Captain Ambrose White in 1848, when he and his family traveled to the area and decided it would be a great place to settle. The city has a rich history from its beginnings as the "wild and wooly west" to its current development. Located in Grayson County, the population of Whitesboro was 4,291 people in 2022.

The city offers a warm, small town charm reflective of its founding. Whitesboro's active Main Street offers gift boutiques, antiques, coffee and dining. Some annual events in the city include the Annual Peanut Festival and the Whitesboro Downtown Christmas celebration. The Parks and Recreation Department provide park amenities in 5 different locations throughout town.

Highway 82 passes through the northern side of the city and Highway 377 passes through the eastern side. The city is just 17 miles from Sherman, TX, the county seat; 13 miles from Gainesville, TX; and 15 miles from the Oklahoma border. Lake Texoma is just 15 minutes north of Whitesboro, and the Hagerman Nation Wildlife Refuge is 16 miles northeast.
