

PROPERTY DESCRIPTION

The property represents one of the last large industrial parcels from the Willamette Valley up to the Portland Metro area. The parcel size offers a wide array of development opportunities, including a mixed-use project.

Approximately 17 acres of the site could be used for medium-to-high density residential product, which can be sold separately. The City of Dallas supports the land use change, subject to an application process.

The property currently produces approximately \$15,000 per month in income from leases.



Dallas is in the heart of the Mid-Willamette Valley, known for its world-class wines produced in communities around the region. But grapes are just one of nearly 200 different crops produced in the three-county region, including hops, hazelnuts, grass seed, and nursery stock. Dallas is part of the Salem Metropolitan Statistical Area. The city of Salem, just 15 miles from Dallas, is the region's largest cities. Local employers draw from a large pool of workers; there are more than one million workers in the 45-mile commute shed.








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
