The SQFI is an internationally recognized food safety and quality certification program based upon sound scientific principles consistently applied across all industry sectors. This facility scored 100% on it's most recent inspection.
- Nation Wide Canning is certified by the Kashruth Council of Canada. This not-for-profit organization is Canada's largest Kosher certifier and a leader in the global kosher industry. To qualify as kosher, a facility must be passed by a team of rabbinic inspectors, expert in the intricacies of modern food production as well as the specifics of Kashrut tradition, which ensure that COR-certified food complies with the highest kosher dietary standards.
- Nation Wide Canning is approved for Organic Products, maintains a fish import license, and a Canada Health Hemp grow license.
