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





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## **LOCATION OVERVIEW**



### HIGHWAY ACCESS

Interstate 84 (I-84): This interstate highway runs east-west through Hermiston, connecting it with major cities like Portland to the west and Boise, Idaho, to the east. In Hermiston, I-84 provides access to local businesses, residences, and serves as a primary route for travelers passing through the area.

Interstate 82 (I-82): Though not directly passing through Hermiston, I-82 is nearby and plays a significant role in the region's transportation network. Hermiston Municipal Airport: While not a commercial airport, Hermiston has its own municipal airport primarily used for general aviation purposes. It's located about 5 miles northwest of downtown Hermiston and serves private and recreational flyers, as well as corporate and charter flights.





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












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
