This unique property offers an equestrian paradise with a custom made metal horse barn with seven stalls, a trainer/manager room on the second level, a one bedroom apartment, paddocks, and a training circle, all on 4.46 +/- acres of land. (Additional land is available adjacent to the paddocks.)

The 6,779 sf building was constructed in 2014 and features an Arcadian Horse Stall system, poured concrete floors, a tack room, hay loft, central aisle drain, and four stalls with doors leading to the paddock. The barn area also has a half bath with pine tongue and groove walls, a grooming stall, feed prep room and storage areas. **\$900,000 was invested in the barn & fencing.**

The location is across the street from the South Pond which flows into Sandy Pond











Tax Map – 5 Ouderkirk Road

One Bedroom Apartment

The property has a one bedroom apartment on the first floor of the barn. It is approximately 1,384 sf with a full bath, kitchen with appliances, and a walk in closet. The apartment is currently being used by a friend of the seller's and will be vacant Summer, 2025. According to Zillow, the average one bedroom apartment in Oswego County rents for \$1,050 per month. The market could support as mucha as \$1500 per month, plus utilities.



Manager/Trainer's Office

On the second floor of the barn is an office/apartment that could be used for a trainer or managers's office as well as an apartment. Finishes are excellent and a small combo kitchen could be installed. There is a shower and excellent finishes. With some upgrades, this has the potential to add additional revenue to the property.
