PROPERTY OVERVIEW

BUILDING

600 Valley River Center is located in the Valley River Center regional shopping mall in Eugene, Oregon. The building was most recently Gottchalks department store and is currently in the planning process to convert the 2nd floor into office space. The spacious floor plate lends itself well to call centers or large corporate users. The large atrium skylights brings in lots of natural light in addition to the exterior windows that will be added to the building.

LOCATION

The building is located along the scenic river-trail system on the north side of the Willamette River. The property has great access to Delta Highway, two exits south of Beltline, giving it great connectivity to all Eugene/Springfield sub-markets. The property also has immediate access to retail amenities at Valley River Center, the area's dominant super-regional mall and close proximity to Downtown Eugene.


















EUGENE, OREGON
