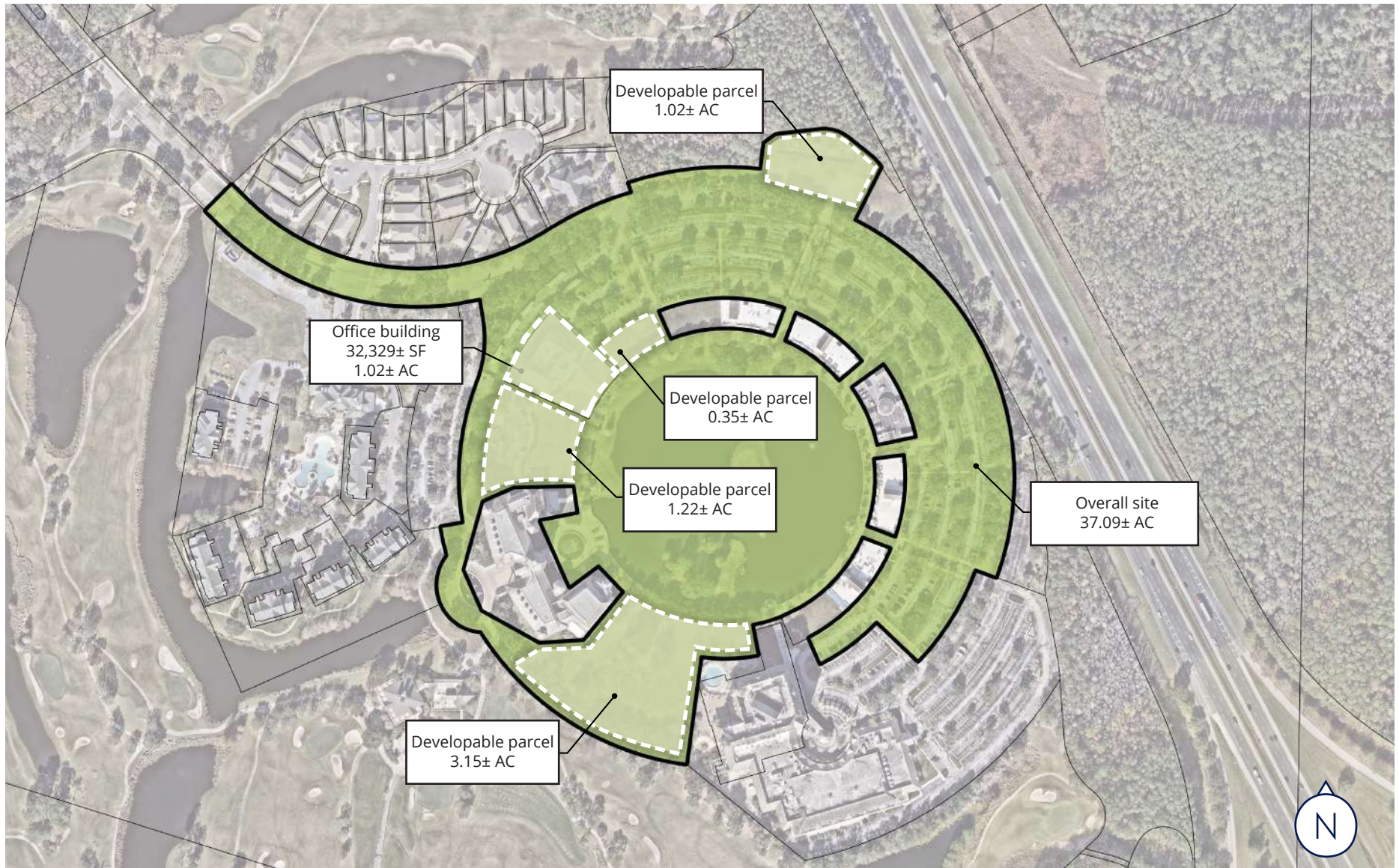

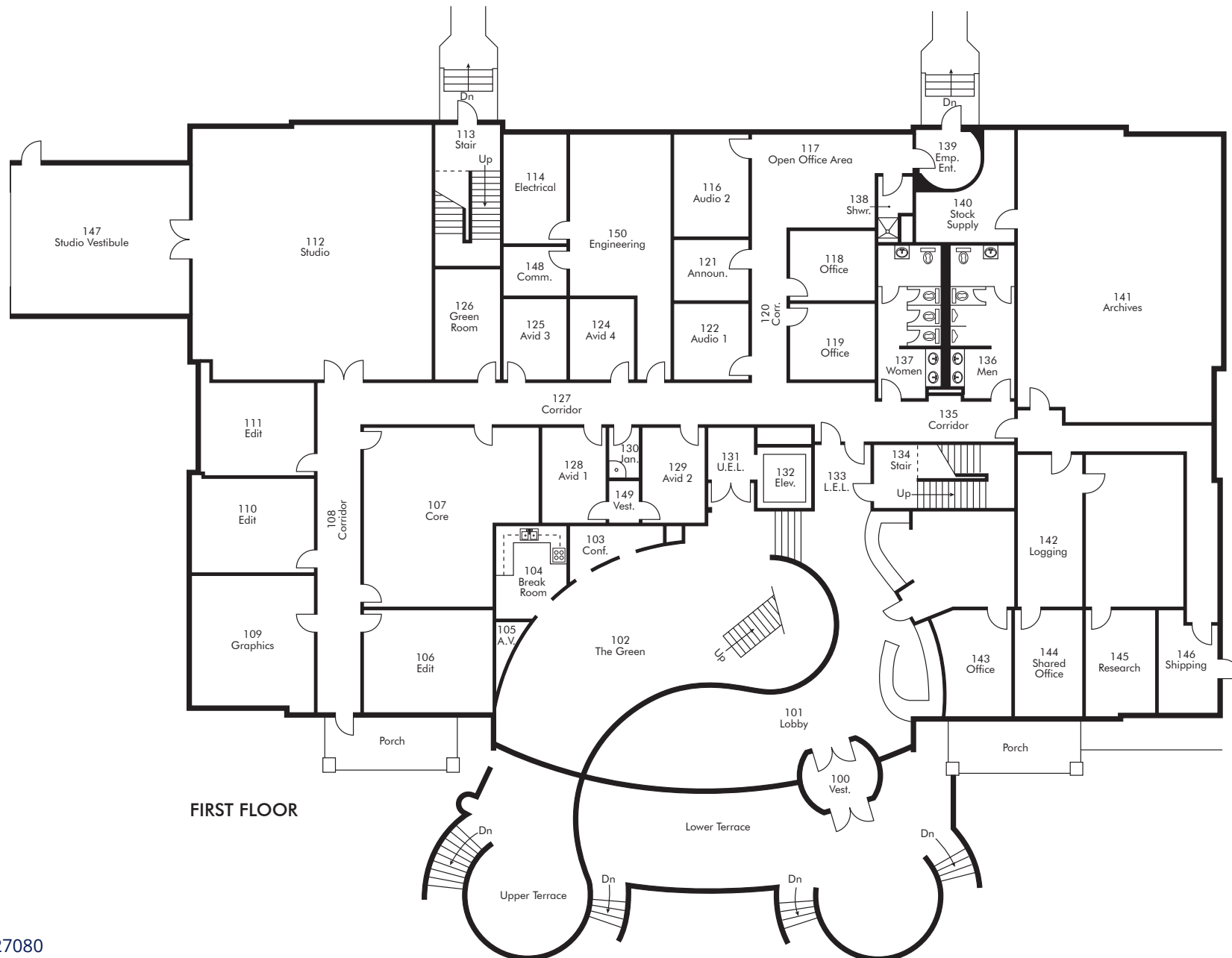


Master Site Plan

Office Building | First Floor

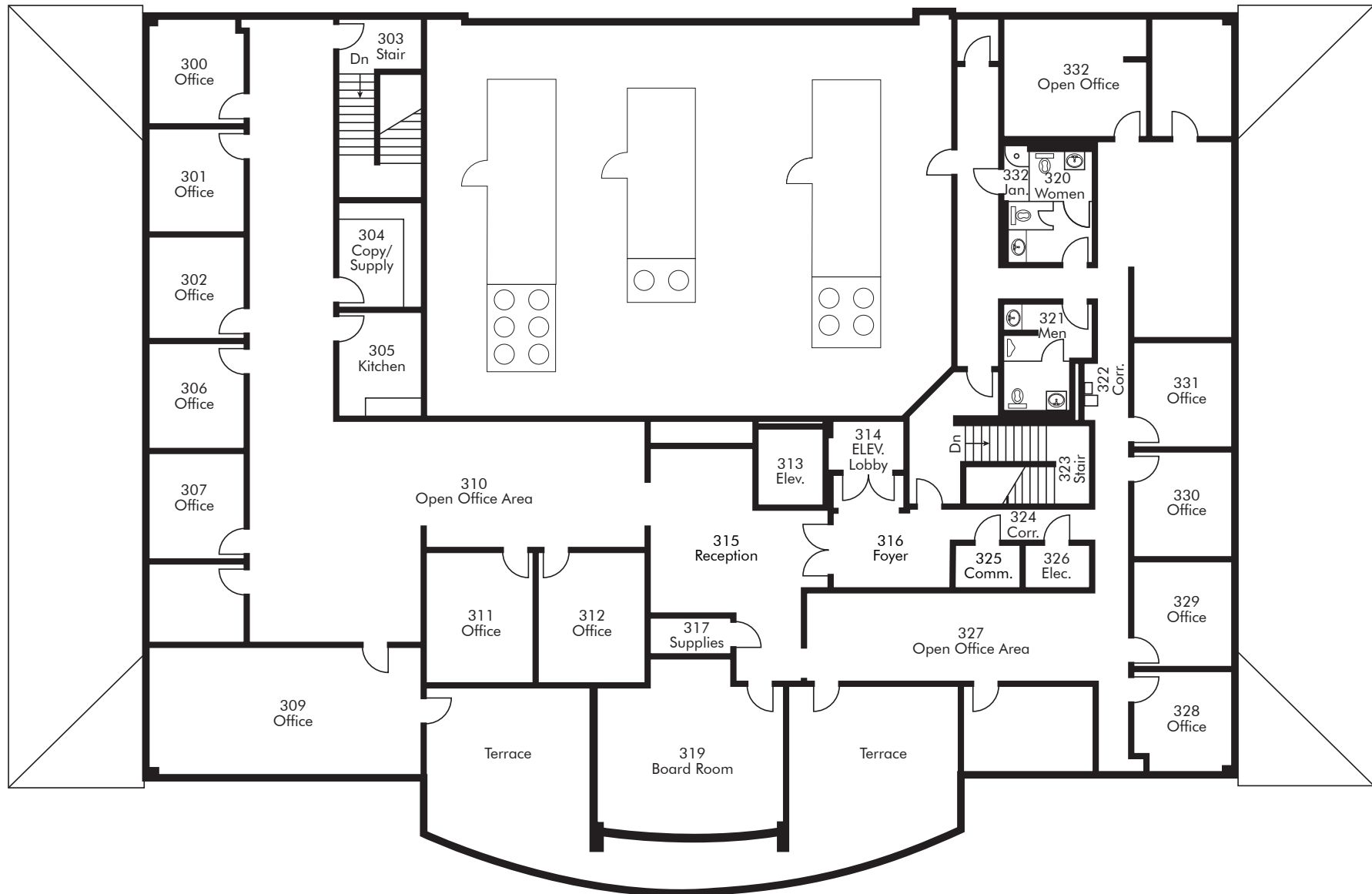


Office Building | Second Floor

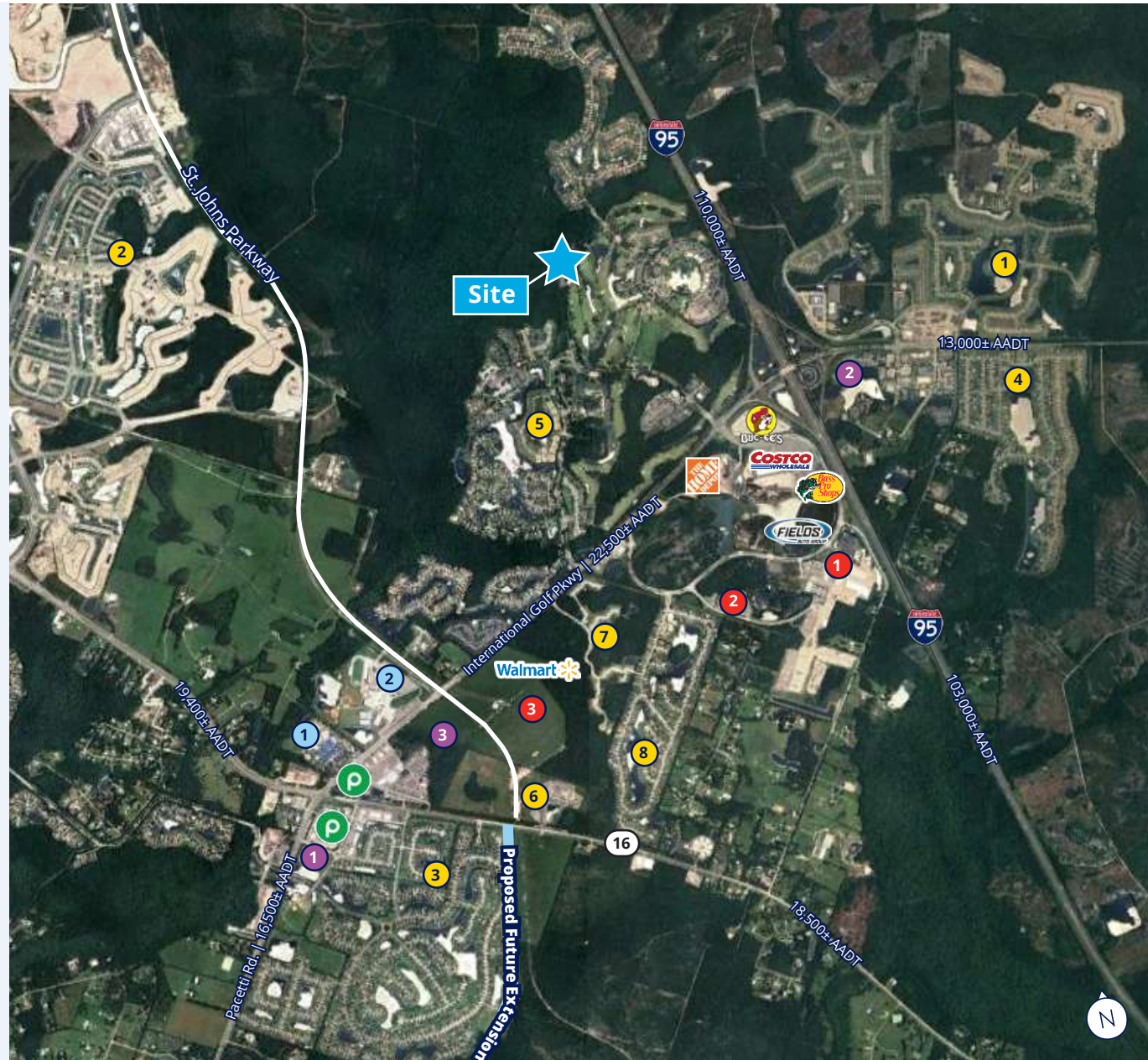

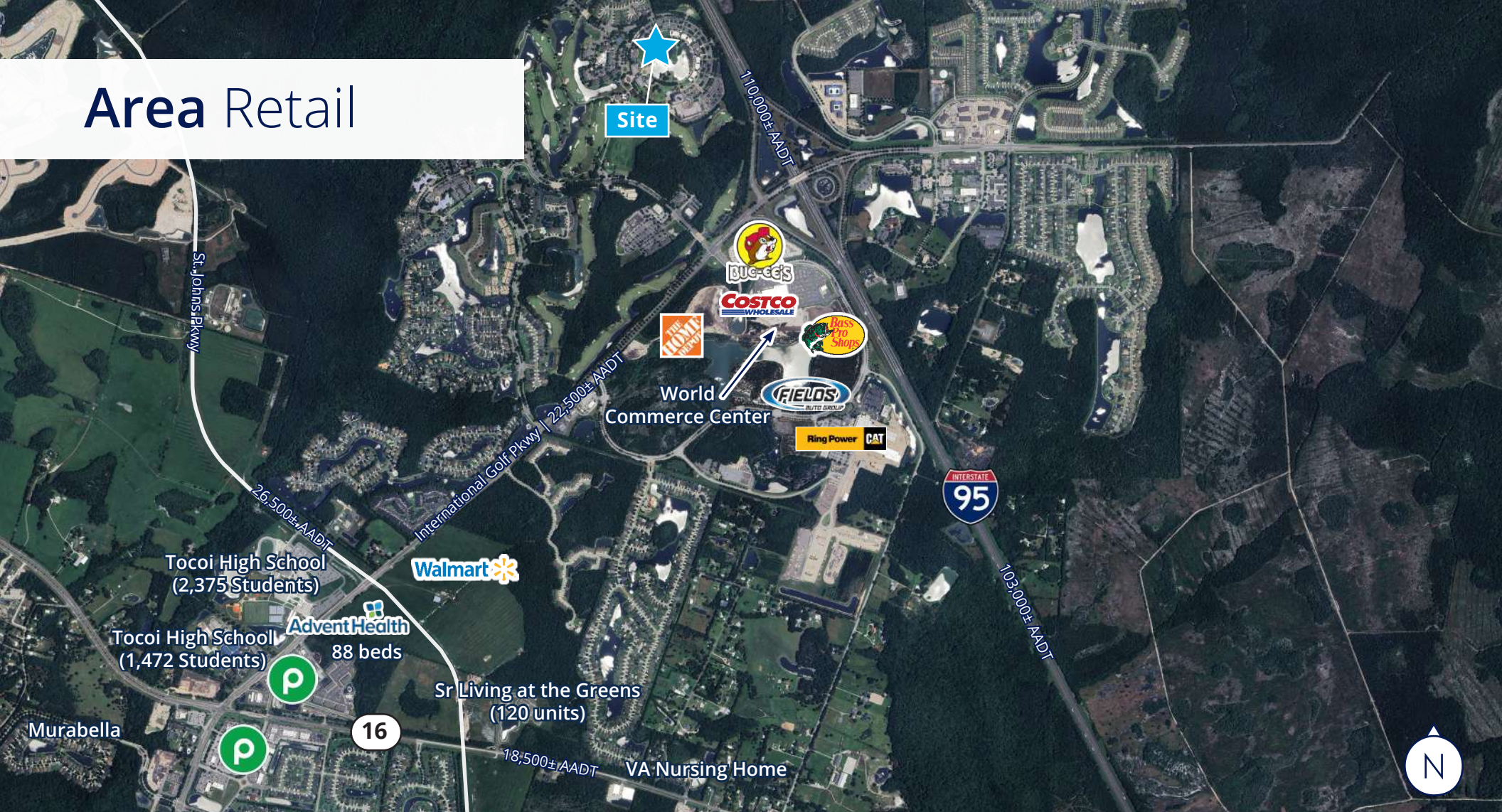
