

Neighborhood highlights

2456 Lincoln Street, Hollywood, Florida 33020, United States is located in the neighborhood of North Central in Hollywood.



Transport

Physically active property owners will welcome the reasonably walk-friendly nature of North Central; most daily needs are convenient to carry out on foot, and a good number of businesses of different types can be found as well. Getting around by transit can be difficult in this neighborhood due to the infrequent service. However, cars are a very good transportation option in this area. It is convenient to park, and nearby highways, such as Interstate 95, are very easy to access from anywhere in North Central.

Services

Residents will welcome that wherever their house is located in North Central, primary schools are close by. However, it can be challenging to reach high schools as a pedestrian. House buyers have the choice between public and private elementary schools. With respect to food, it is straightforward to reach the nearest grocery store by walking in North Central. Moreover, a restaurant is often just around the corner, and property owners benefit from a few cafes as well. Residents can find a fair number of nearby clothing stores.

Character

North Central offers a wide selection of green spaces to enjoy, as well as some areas with a vibrant atmosphere. It is easy to get to parks from most locations within the neighborhood since there are a few of them nearby for residents to check out. Finally, this part of the city remains relatively quiet, since there are few pedestrians; however there can be higher levels of noise for those who are near the railway line or Interstate 95.

Housing

Single detached homes are the predominant housing type, representing around 40% of buildings in North Central, and the rest of the dwellings are mainly large apartment buildings, small apartment buildings, and duplexes. This part of the city is primarily composed of one bedroom and two bedroom homes. Roughly two thirds of the population of this neighborhood rent their home and the rest are owners. Most of the housing growth in this part of the city occurred before the 1960s.


Community portrait























Climate Risk

Heat

Fire




