The five-year projection for the population in the area is 168,888 representing a change of -0.30% annually from 2024 to 2029. Currently, the population is 48.5% male and 51.5% female.

The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 63.2 in the identified area, compared to 72.5 for the U.S. as a whole.

Current median household income is \$89,034 in the area, compared to \$79,068 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$103,150 in five years, compared to \$91,442 all U.S. households.

Current average household income is \$127,147 in this area, compared to \$113,185 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$145,696 in five years, compared to \$130,581 for all U.S. households.

Current per capita income is \$53,926 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$43,829. The per capita income is projected to be \$63,246 in five years, compared to \$51,203 for all U.S. households.

Currently, 61.2% of the 77,969 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.0%, renter occupied; and 6.9% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 57.9% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.1% are renter occupied; and 10.0% are vacant. In 2020, there were 76,278 housing units in the area and 6.9% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 0.52%. Median home value in the area is \$391,727, compared to a median home value of \$355,577 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.61% annually to \$445,627.
