Currently, 51.7% of the 27,846 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 35.8%, renter occupied; and 12.5% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 57.3% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.2% are renter occupied; and 11.5% are vacant. In 2010, there were 27,921 housing units in the area - 53.3% owner occupied, 35.8% renter occupied, and 10.9% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is -0.12%.
