

Elmhurst was founded in Queens, New York in 1925. Current owner Henry Schwartz's father and uncle started the company, which became Elmhurst Dairy, in their father's milk house in the Elmhurst neighborhood. The Schwartz brothers moved to the Jamaica neighborhood in the 1930s. Here they linked with their brother-in-law, who had a farm of 200 cows in Middle Village, and set up a manufacturing plant. By the 21st century, Elmhurst's milk could be found across New York City, from elementary schools to Starbucks.

The Jamaica site housed Elmhurst Dairy until its closure in 2016. It was the last remaining fluid milk plant in New York City. Elmhurst had been producing more than 5.6 million guarts a week.

Elmhurst Dairy rebranded itself as Elmhurst 1925, and switched its focus from dairy to plant-based milks produced by it's parent company Steuben Foods.



Jamaica is a neighborhood in the New York City borough of Queens. It is mainly composed of a large commercial and retail area, though part of the neighborhood is also residential.


