







PARCEL MAP




ATCHISON ST

RIVERBANK

In 2022, Riverbank, CA had a population of 24.8k people with a median age of 33.6 and a median household income of \$89,504. Between 2021 and 2022 the population of Riverbank, CA grew from 24,714 to 24,803, a 0.36% increase and its median household income grew from \$75,216 to \$89,504, a 19% increase.

The 5 largest ethnic groups in Riverbank, CA are White (Non-Hispanic) (33.7%), Two+ (Hispanic) (20.3%), White (Hispanic) (20.2%), Other (Hispanic) (13.4%), and Asian (Non-Hispanic) (6.26%).

None of the households in Riverbank, CA reported speaking a non-English language at home as their primary shared language. This does not consider the potential multilingual nature of households, but only the primary self-reported language spoken by all members of the household.

90.8% of the residents in Riverbank, CA are U.S. citizens.

In 2022, the median property value in Riverbank, CA was \$411,300, and the homeownership rate was 69.3%.

Most people in Riverbank, CA drove alone to work, and the average commute time was 28.8 minutes. The average car ownership in Riverbank, CA was 2 cars per household.

POPULATION & DIVERSITY

Riverbank, CA is home to a population of 24.8k people, from which 90.8% are citizens. As of 2022, 22% of Riverbank, CA residents were born outside of the country (5.46k people).

In 2022, there were 1.66 times more White (Non-Hispanic) residents (8.37k people) in Riverbank, CA than any other race or ethnicity. There were 5.04k Two+ (Hispanic) and 5.02k White (Hispanic) residents, the second and third most common ethnic groups.

ECONOMY

The economy of Riverbank, CA employs 10.6k people. The largest industries in Riverbank, CA are Manufacturing (1,480 people), Health Care & Social Assistance (1,252 people), and Retail Trade (1,084 people), and the highest paying industries are Public Administration (\$92,961), Professional, Scientific, & Technical Services (\$82,768), and Finance & Insurance (\$69,228).

EMPLOYMENT

From 2021 to 2022, employment in Riverbank, CA grew at a rate of 2.86%, from 10.3k employees to 10.6k employees.

The most common job groups, by number of people living in Riverbank, CA, are Office & Administrative Support Occupations (1,284 people), Management Occupations (904 people), and Production Occupations (900 people).
