



PROPERTY & MARKET OVERVIEW

Join the newly reopened Yorktowne Hotel, a Tapestry Collection by Hilton in downtown York! Multiple retail/restaurant opportunities exist in the first floor along the Market St. frontage, flanking each side of the turnstile main entrance to the lobby. The premier restaurant space is available from 3,322 SF (including 908 SF Kitchen) up to 4,863 SF, with approx. 90-feet of storefront glass frontage along Market St. affording tremendous exposure to both vehicular and pedestrian traffic. The corner retail space consists of 768 SF with approx. 75-feet of storefront glass along Market St. and Duke St. Both spaces have direct access to the main hotel lobby, with interior storefront entrances into the lobby. There are also beautifully-appointed shared restrooms in the lobby adjacent to the spaces.

The Yorktowne Hotel features 123 rooms, including 27 extended-stay suites, a ballroom able to handle a capacity up to 400 people, and a rooftop lounge with stunning views of the York City skyline. It's location affords tremendous walk-ability, with easy access to all of downtown York's amenities including The Appell Center for the Performing Arts, Central Market, WellSpan Park, York County History Center, and much more.

The Yorktowne Hotel has been a cornerstone of downtown York since 1925, and embodied a sense of progressiveness and momentum that characterized a City on the move during its opening. Two years after the grand opening of the hotel, an addition was constructed adding hotel rooms and expanding the ballroom. The Yorktowne Hotel featured the elegance of a grand hotel. The 11-story building was designed in Renaissance revival that reflects the vivacious spirit of the 1920s with 20-foot-high ceilings and ornate decor.



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


Located just across the Codorus Creek, WeCo is a diverse business district with restaurants, shopping, entertainment, community activities and local businesses.


