

METES AND BOUNDS DESCRIPTION

Being 64.65 acres of land situated in the R. de la Pena Survey, Abstract No. 3 and being the same tract of land as conveyed from Elizabeth McClain Penny and Suzanne McClain Holley to Altrei, LLC, recorded in Volume 2429, Page 1764, Deed Records, Ellis County, Texas, (D.R.E.C.T.) and also being part of a called 153 acre tract of land, described in Volume 351, Page 441 and a 138.09 acre tract of land, described in Volume 346, Page 556, D.R.E.C.T. and being more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows;

BEGINNING at a Mag Nail set in the centerline of Parker Hill Road, in the southeast line of a called 28.613 acre tract conveyed to Altrei, LLC, recorded in Volume 2393, Page 2386, at the northeast corner of a called 6.468 acre tract conveyed to Sun Development, LP, recorded in Volume 2634, Page 2229, D.R.E.C.T., from which an X-Cut found at the northwest corner of said Sun Development tract bears, S 65° 33′ 51″ E, 457′.80 feet and being the most northerly northwest corner and Point Of Beginning of the herein described tract of land;

THENCE, S 51° 07' 18" E, along and with the southwest line of said 74.673 acre tract, the northeast line of this tract and the centerline of Parker Hill Road, 1,801.88 feet, (called 1,802.58 feet) to a 1/2" iron rod set at the projected centerlines of a bend in Parker Hill Road and the southeast corner of said 74.673 acre tract, in the north line of a called 188.19 acre tract described in Volume 2651, Page 783, D.R.E.C.T.;

THENCE, S 59° 30' 45" W, along and with the northwest line of said 188.19 acre tract and the southeast line of this tract, at 516.87 feet pass an Angle Iron found, 3.1 feet right and continuing a total distance of 595.40 feet, (called 586.22 feet) to a 1/2" iron rod set at an angle point;

THENCE, S 60° 26' 45" W, continuing along and with the southeast line of this tract, 1,522.09 feet to a 3/4" iron pipe found at a fence corner for the northeast corner of a called 3.09 acre tract conveyed to Bowen Living Trust, recorded in Volume 20200302, Pg. DG, (per Ellis County Tax records);

THENCE, S 72° 23' 20" W, along and with the north line of said 3.09 acre tract, the south line of this tract and generally with a fence, 375.75 feet to a Wood Post (right-of-way) Monument found, at a fence corner, in the east right-of-way line of State Highway I-45;

THENCE, N 16° 45' 00" W, along and with the east right-of-way line of State Highway I-45, the west line of this tract and generally with a fence, 51.00 feet to a 1/2" iron rod found at the beginning of a non-tangent curve to the right, having a radius point that bears, N 73° 14' 01" E, 5,579.58 feet and a long chord that bears, N 14° 49' 56" W, 584.16 feet; THENCE, NORTHWESTERLY, along and with said curve to the right, the east right-of-way line of State Highway I-45 and the west line of this tract, 584.43 feet to a Wood Post (right-of-way) Monument found at the end of curve;

THENCE, N 01° 30′ 58" W, continuing with the east right-of-way line of State Highway I-45, the west line of this tract and generally with a fence, 122.29 feet, (called 111.83 feet) to a 1/2" iron rod found at a northwest corner of this tract and the southwest corner of a called 3.164 owned by Knox Oil of Texas, Inc. recorded in Volume 603, Page 780, D.R.E.C.T.; THENCE, N 07° 22' 47" W, continuing with the east right-of-way line of State Highway I-45, the west line of this tract and generally with a fence, 308.75 feet, (called 291.89 feet) to a 1/2" iron rod set at an angle point;

THENCE, N 87° 32' 14" E, along and with the south line of said 3.164 acre tract and generally with a fence, 489.00 feet to a 1/2" iron rod found at the southeast corner of said 3.164 acre tract and an interior corner of this tract;

THENCE, N 03° 18' 17" W, along and with the west line of this tract, the east line of said 3.164 acre tract and said 6.468 acre tract, 973.89 feet, (called 999.38 feet) the POINT OF BEGINNING, containing 2,816,354 square feet or 64.65 acres of land.
