PROPERTY OVERVIEW

MLS 270017 - Available for lease in Walla Walla, WA, this newly constructed light industrial building sits on a ± 0.89 -acre lot and offers $\pm 4,304$ SF of total space, including ± 704 SF of office space and $\pm 3,600$ SF of warehouse space. Built in 2023, the property is designed for efficiency and functionality, with heating and cooling systems included for the office area. With ample parking and a fenced laydown yard, this is a great space for a variety of operations.

The 5-year term modified gross lease includes snow removal, landscaping, and landscape water, while the tenant is responsible for electricity (separately metered by Columbia REA), internet, garbage, and water. If desired, a propane furnace can be added to heat the warehouse for an additional \$8,000 (tenant responsible for tank rental and fuel). With an average daily traffic count of approximately $\pm 9,000$, this property offers great visibility and accessibility for your business.

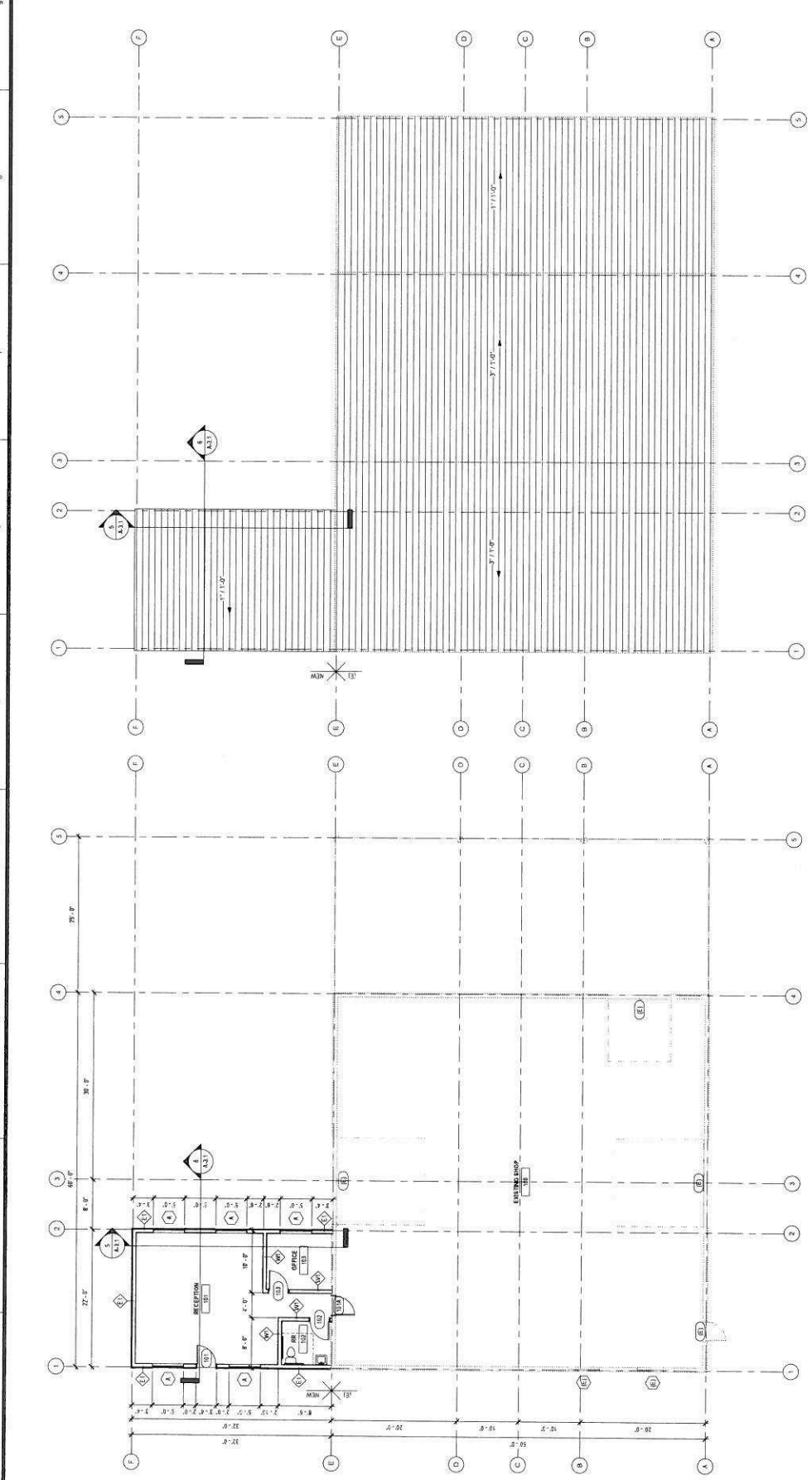

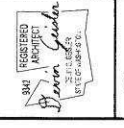

LOCATION MAP

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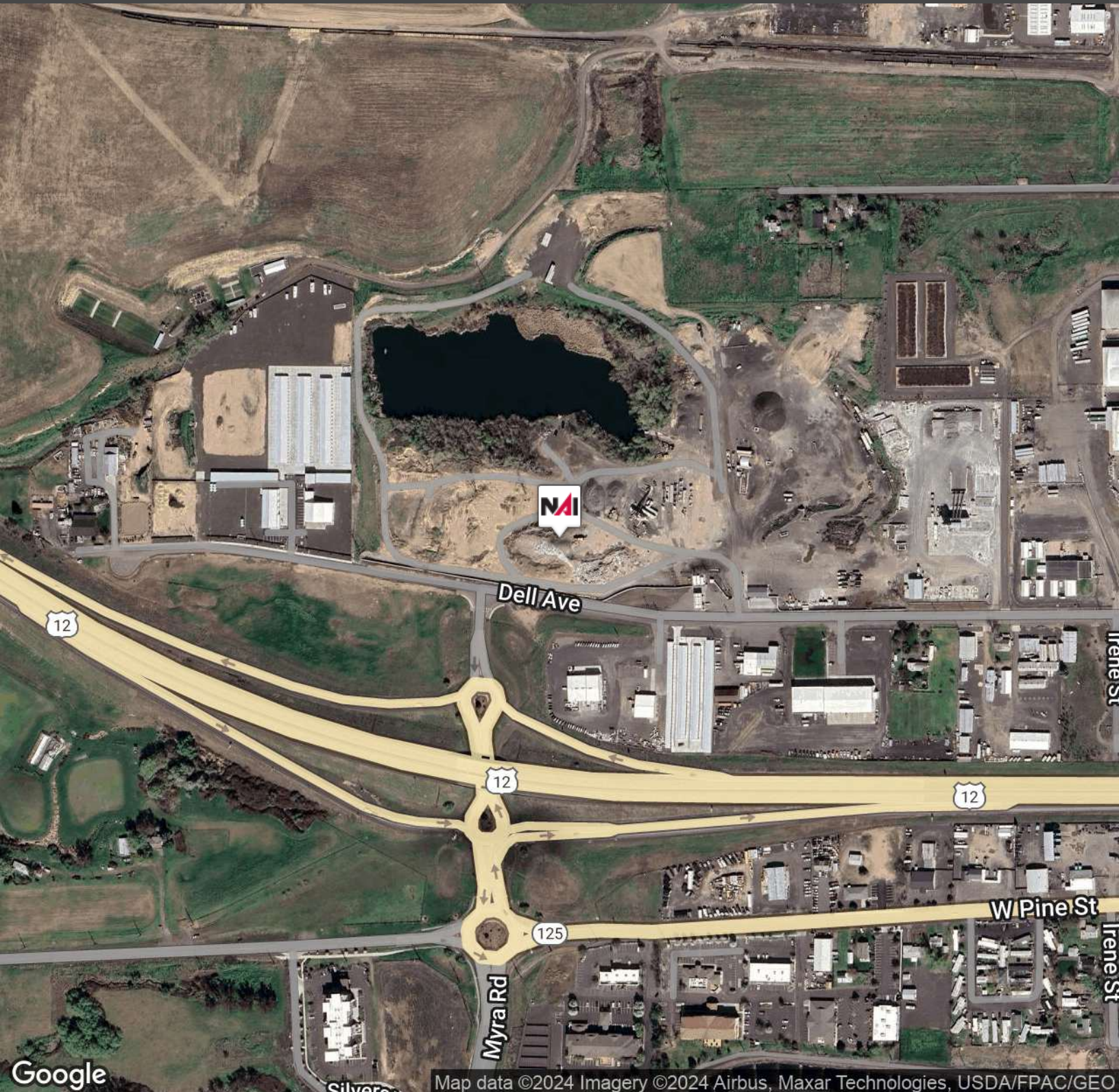
