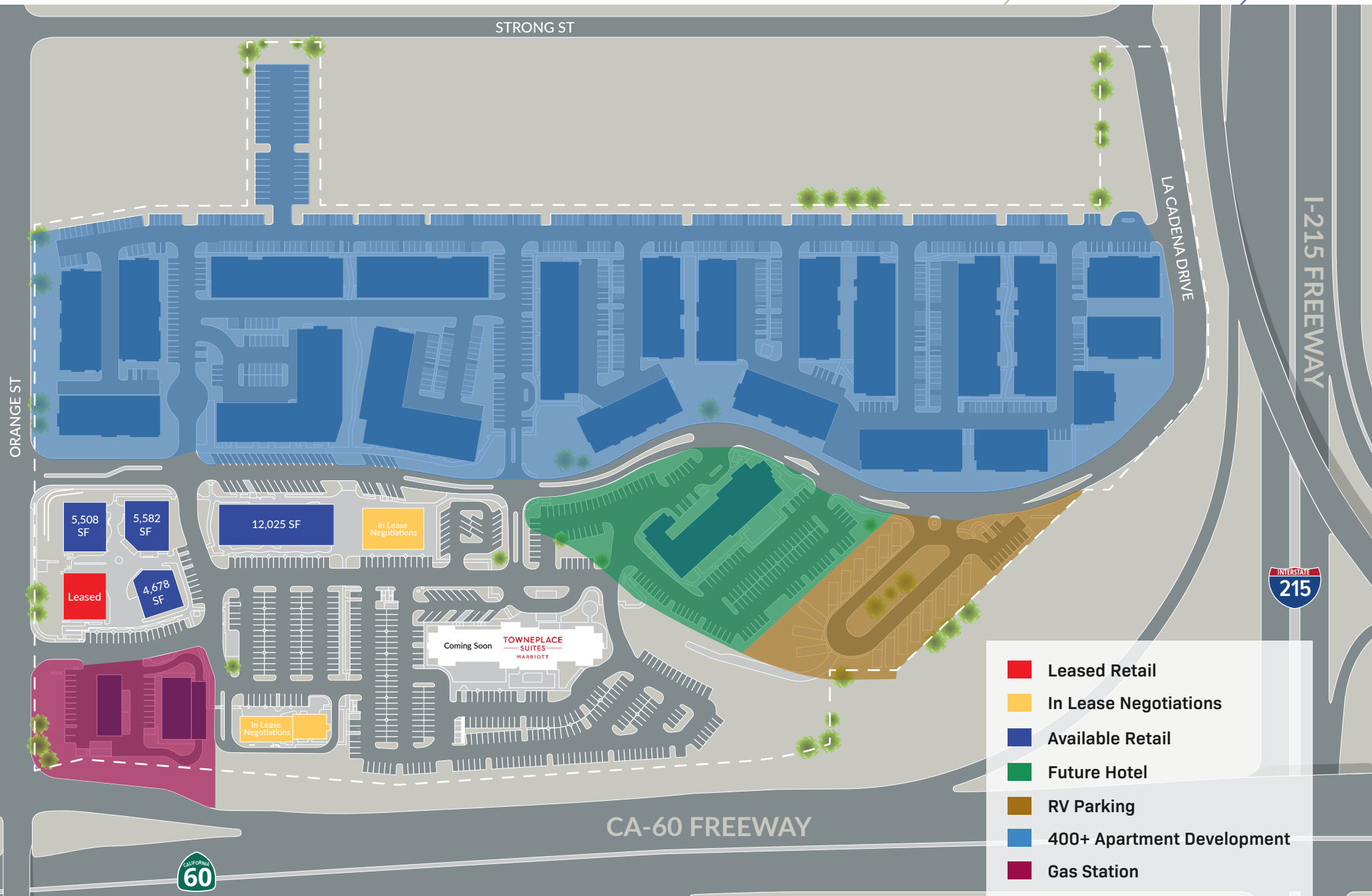

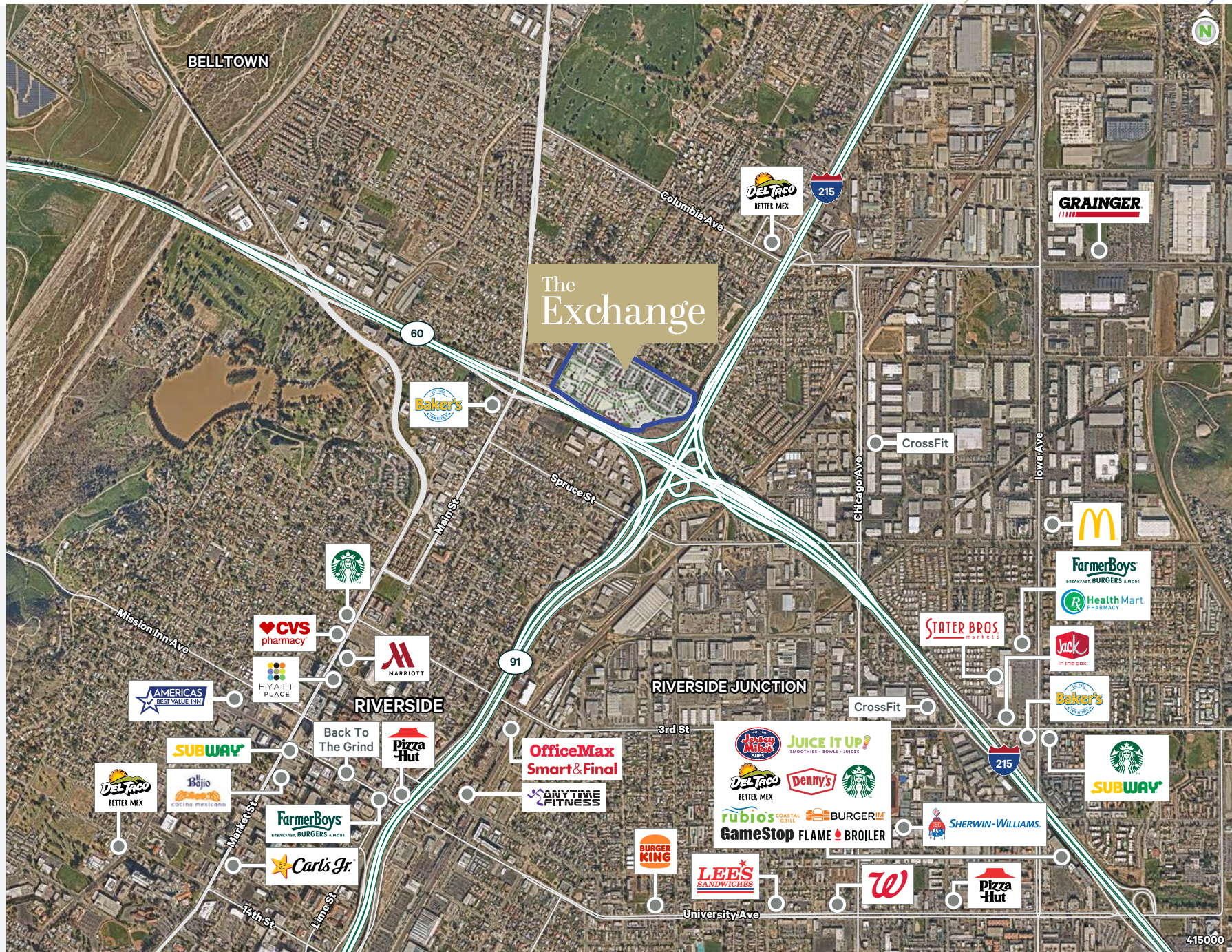
Demographics

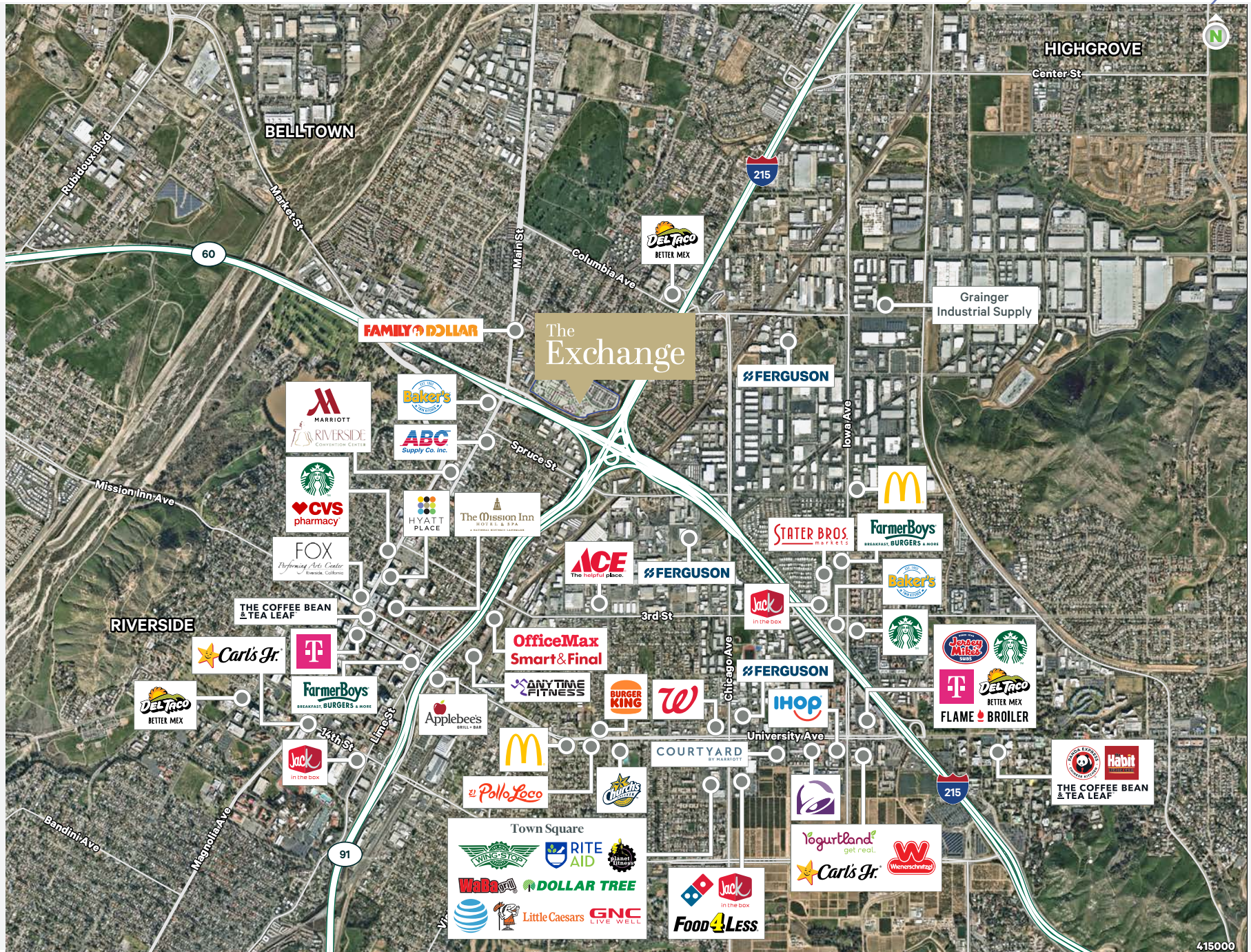
