EXTERIOR OF THE BUILDING

With its main entrance on 14th Street, this building used to be the house of Karu & Y This space was a high-end restaurant and nightclub that operated in the mid-2000s. It was known for its luxurious design and innovative dining experiences. The venue featured multiple areas, including a fine-dining restaurant, lounges, and outdoor spaces, with decor that aimed to offer an upscale and immersive experience.





FRONT PATIO

This space features two waterfalls, six cabanas, and a bar uniquely situated beneath one of the transparent waterfalls, creating a dynamic and immersive ambiance. Adorned with lush plants throughout, it provides a serene yet vibrant atmosphere. This area serves as the welcoming entryway before stepping into Red Room, making it an ideal space for guests to gather and enjoy the scenery.








LONG ROOM

The Long Room is one of the main areas of the venue and was previously used as the main bar. It features a solid granite countertop, a fully equipped bar, access to the kitchen, audio equipment, and multiple televisions, making it a versatile and functional space





VENINI ROOM

Named after the custom-made blown glass art piece created by Paolo Venini, this 18' by 22' room serves as an extension of the Long Bar, seamlessly complementing its functionality and design.



CHIHULY ROOM

Also named after the centerpiece of this room, the Chihuly Room is adorned with a custom-made chandelier designed specifically for this space. Previously, this room served as the main dining area of the restaurant, offering an elegant and distinctive atmosphere.







CLUB ROOM

The largest room in the building, the Club Room boasts over 5,000 square feet of open space and was previously used as the main dancing area.

This space features a dedicated DJ booth, a bar, and direct access to the Back Garden. Additionally, it includes a small kitchen designed to provide services for both the Club Room and the Back Garden, making it ideal for hosting events.







This oasis in the heart of Downtown Miami offers an open 2,000-square-foot central space, surrounded by eight islands that once featured cabanas, a tiki bar, waterfalls, and six individual restrooms. Designed with both accessibility and exclusivity in mind, this unique area can accommodate up to 700 people and offers direct access to the front of the building as well as private entry points.








CURRENTLY
