The five-year projection for the population in the area is 200,232 representing a change of 0.59% annually from 2019 to 2024. Currently, the population is 48.3% male and 51.7% female.

The number of families in the current year is 49,153 in the specified area.

Currently, 54.8% of the 92,486 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 36.3%, renter occupied; and 9.0% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.4% are renter occupied; and 11.2% are vacant. In 2010, there were 88,522 housing units in the area - 55.8% owner occupied, 35.0% renter occupied, and 9.3% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 1.97%. Median home value in the area is \$195,341, compared to a median home value of \$234,154 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 3.99% annually to \$237,518.

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
