Features a freight elevator with street access, covered loading area with 15' clear height, and modern lobby and common areas with premium finishes.













# **FLOOR PLAN**





### **AERIAL MAP**






# **RETAILER MAP**

### VILLAGE OF TUCKAHOE

Tuckahoe is a small village located in the town of Eastchester. It is a vibrant and diverse community that offers a high quality of life. The village has a charming downtown area that features a mix of locally owned businesses, including restaurants, cafes, shops, and professional services.
