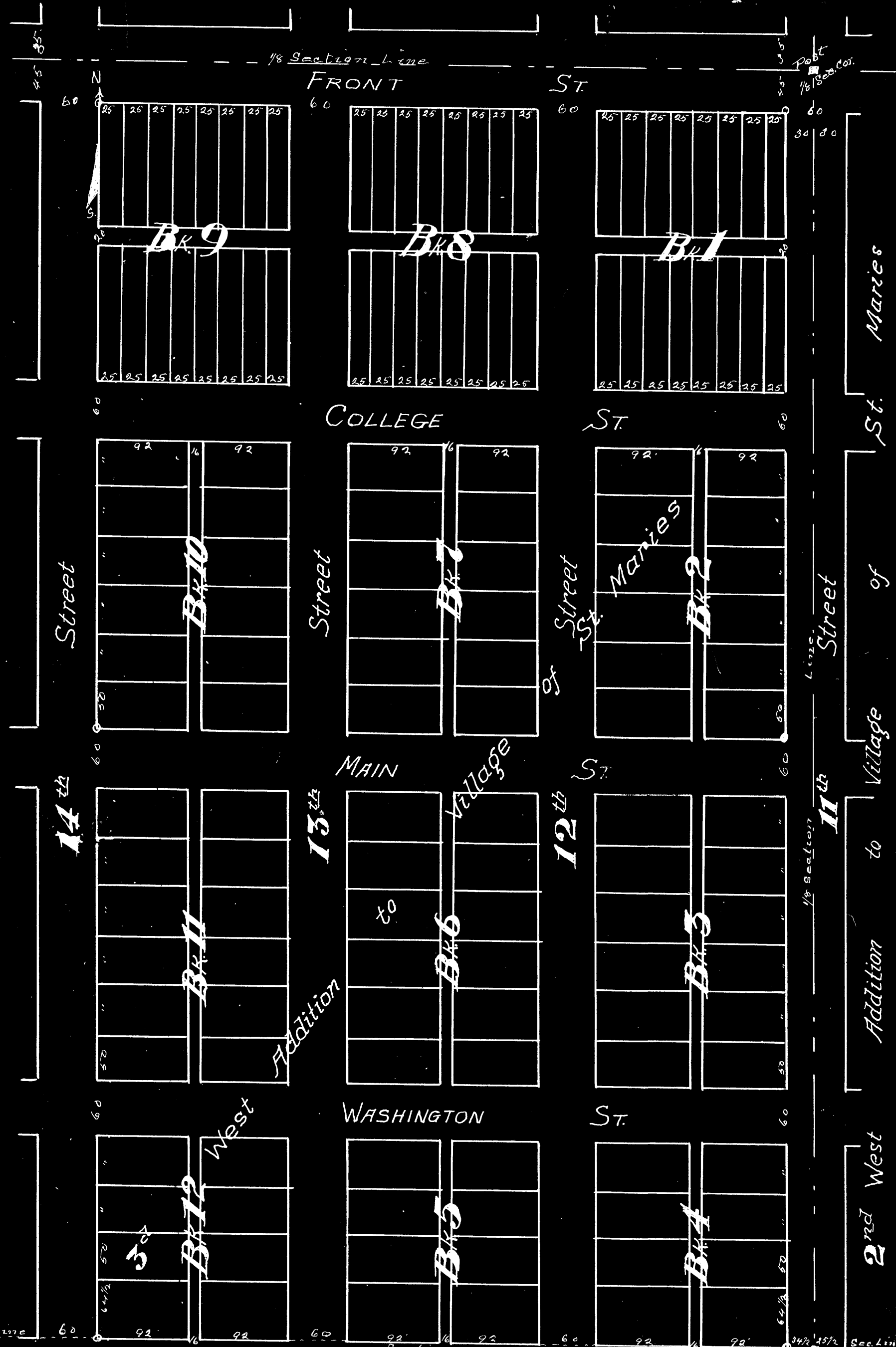


Plat of 3rd West Addition to the Village of St. Maries, Idaho
