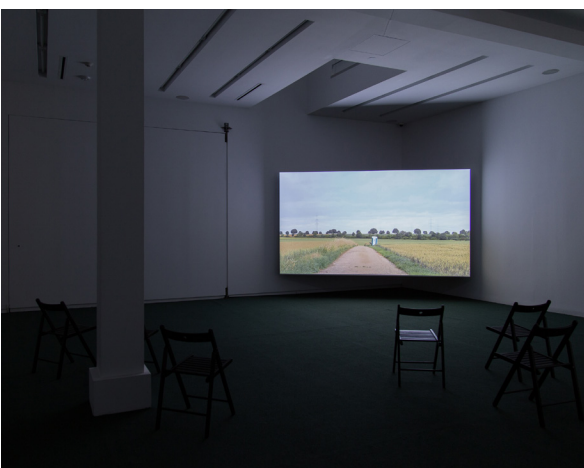


Kavi Gupta | Elizabeth St.

Since opening in 2013, the space has hosted some of the most important exhibitions in the gallery's history, debuting with Roxy Paine's *Apparatus*, which won the AICA-USA award for the best commercial gallery show in the nation. Supplementing the exhibitions, pioneering programming in the space has included panel discussions, performances, and screenings.

Kavi Gupta | New Buffalo



Currently under construction, Kavi Gupta | New Buffalo is our satellite space in the historic New Buffalo, Michigan. Situated directly across Lake Michigan from Chicago, the New Buffalo community has long been an escape for Chicago artists. Our vision for the space is as part artist retreat and part experimental exhibition hall, worthy of a minor pilgrimage for patrons of the arts.

Kavi Gupta | Warehouse



Our 11,000-sqft. warehouse in Chicago serves more functions than storage. The multifaceted facility is equal parts archive, documentation space, conservation center, and fabrication facility. The warehouse includes both a woodshop and resources for collaborating with our artists to fabricate innovative new projects.

Kavi Gupta | Editions



Kavi Gupta | Editions is the gallery's publishing arm, producing over a dozen publications annually. Publishing both independently and in collaboration with museums, publishing houses, and specialist small presses, Editions is a critical mode for our outreach to the world at large. Editions also operates a curated bookshop featuring acclaimed art publications and editioned objects.

Kavi Gupta | Archives



Scholars and patrons know Kavi Gupta | Archives as an invaluable resource. In collaboration with collectors and artists, our archives have amassed exceptional holdings, including a photo archive of African American history 1845–1960, Civil Rights materials pertaining to the Black Panthers and AFRICOBRA, and numerous rare publications. Among the many objects in the archives are never-before-seen examples of luminaries such as James Van Der Zee, first-edition books from the 19th century, and the complete photo archives of Willie “The Lion” Smith.
