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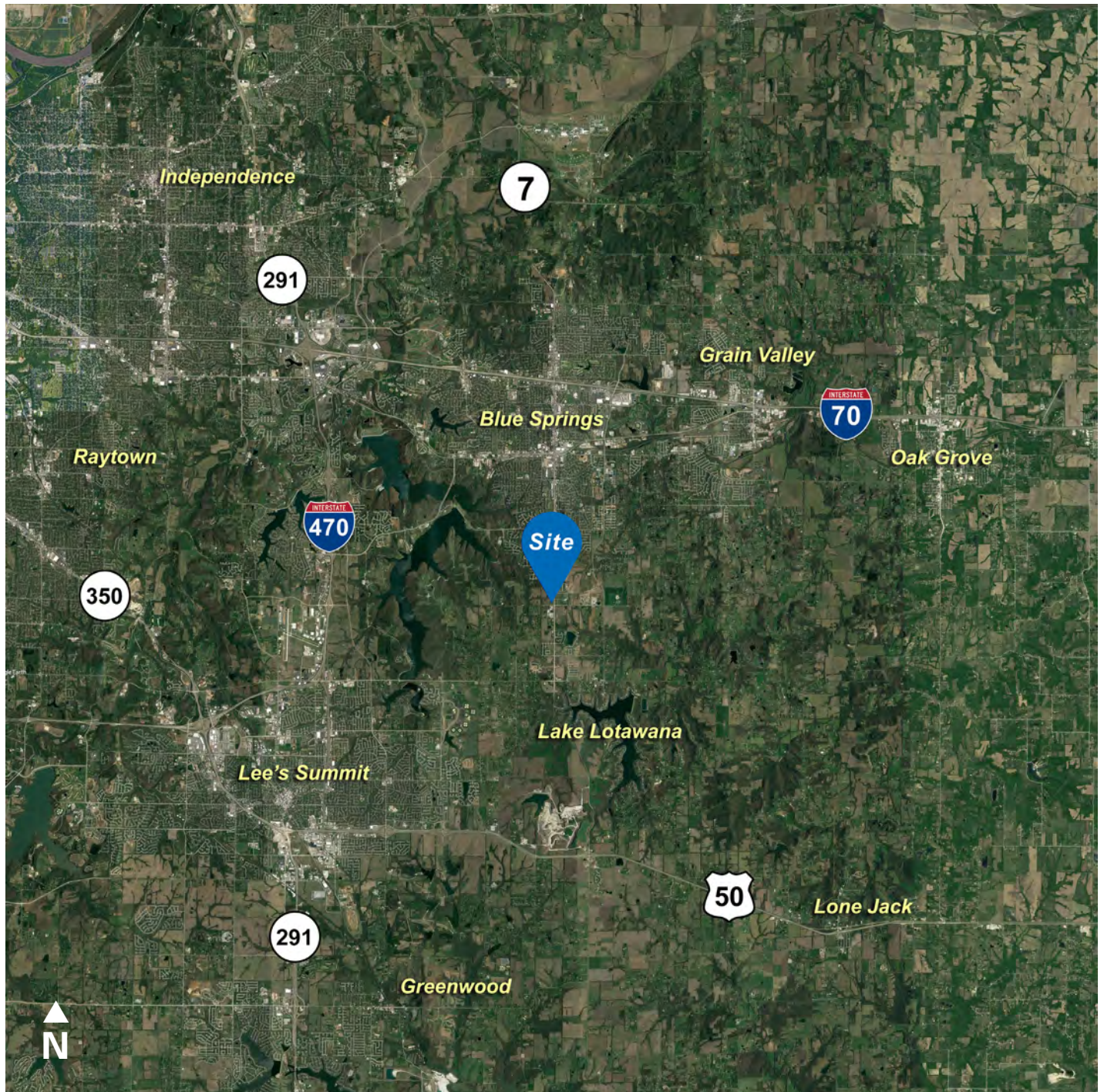
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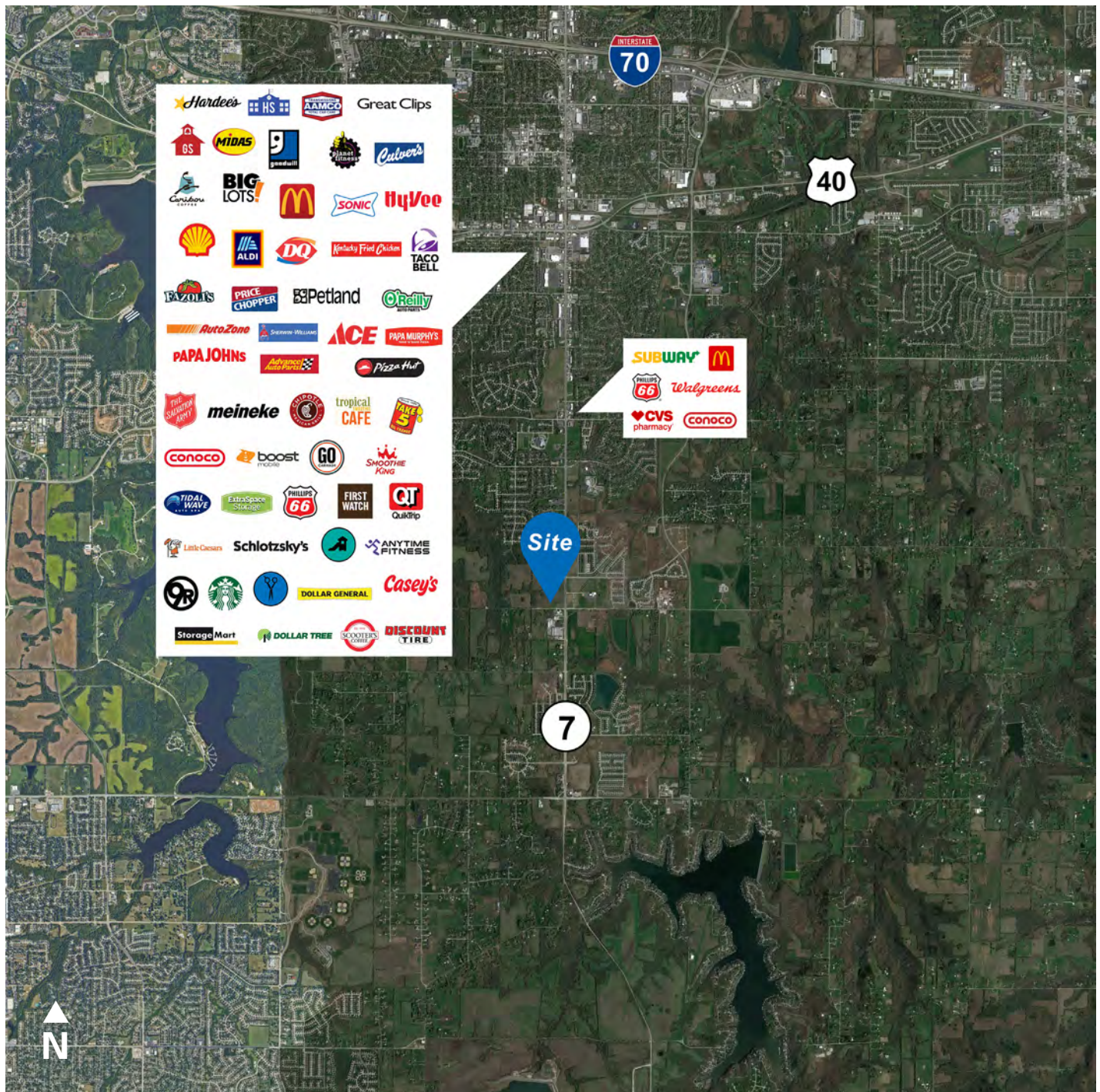

Current median household income is \$77,779 in the area, compared to \$60,548 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$85,920 in five years, compared to \$69,180 for all U.S. households

Currently, 66.7% of the 32,216 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 27.1%, renter occupied; and 6.1% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.4% are renter occupied; and 11.2% are vacant. In 2010, there were 30,385 housing units in the area - 68.7% owner occupied, 24.3% renter occupied, and 7.0% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 2.63%. Median home value in the area is \$195,660, compared to a median home value of \$234,154 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 3.71% annually to \$234,775.

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
