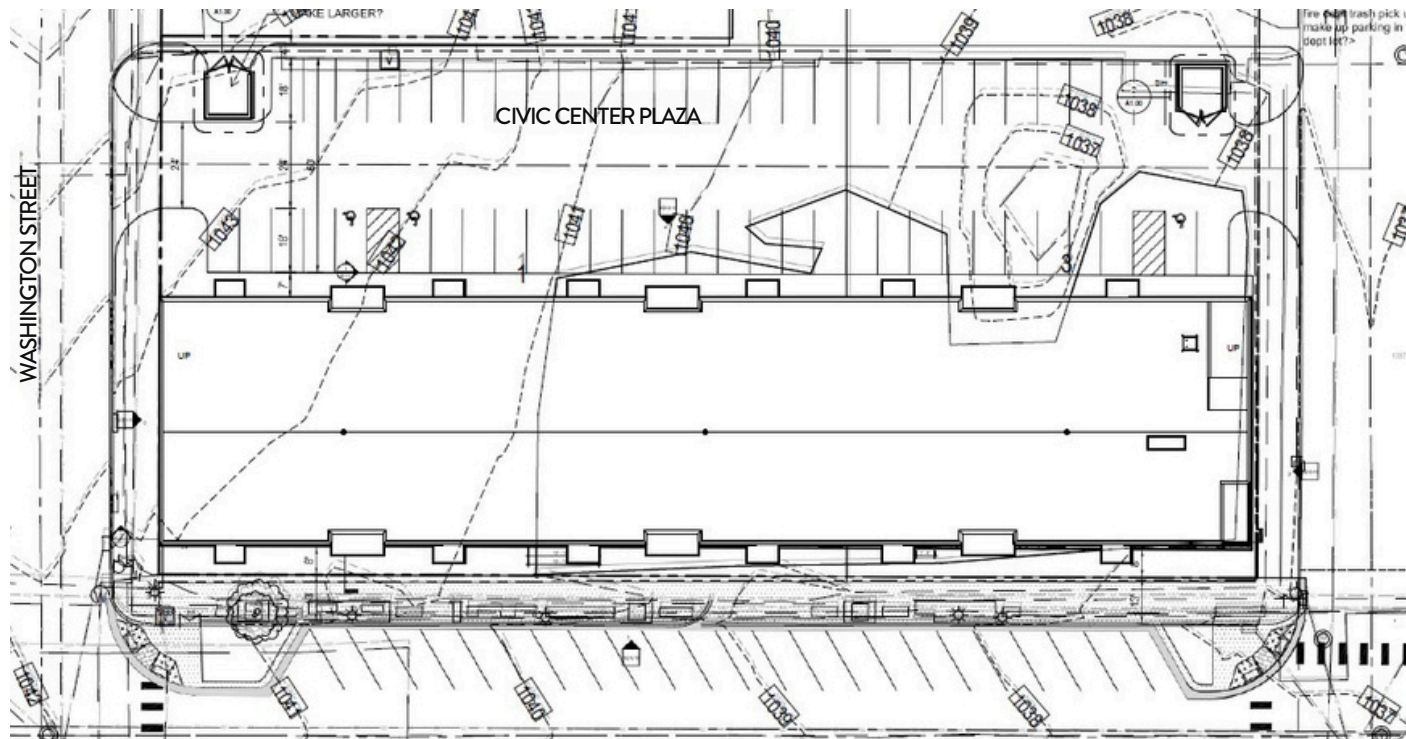
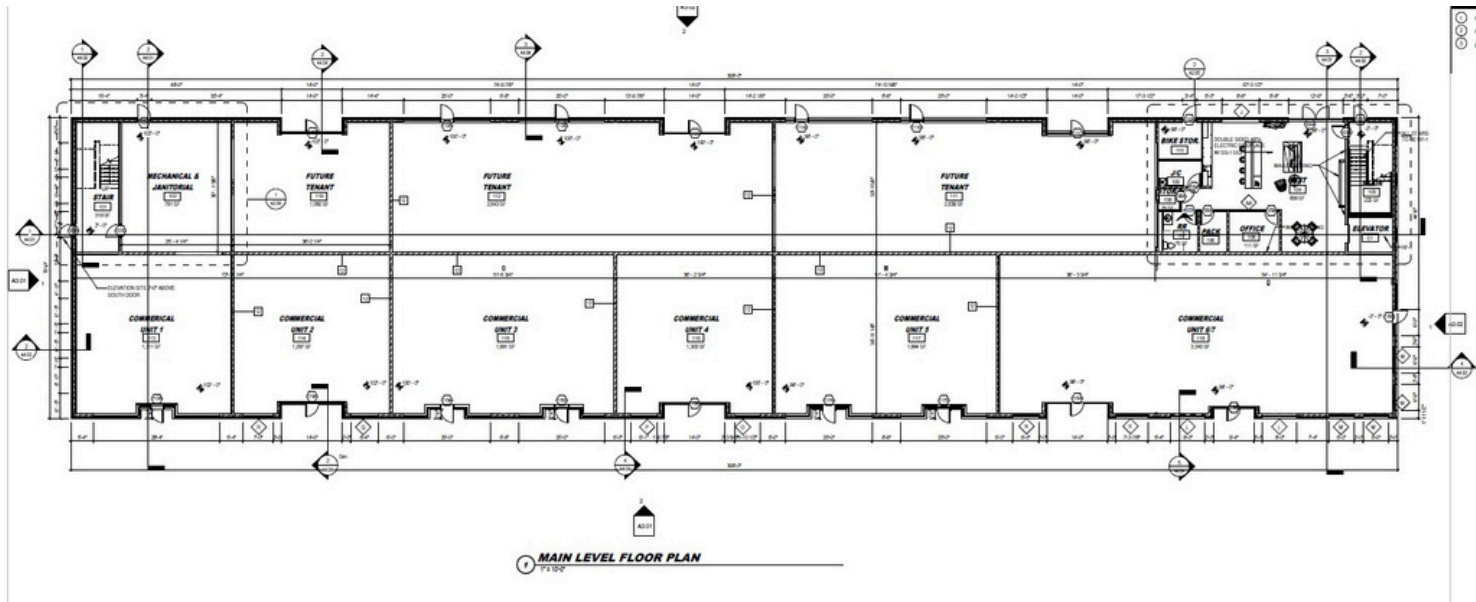


HOUSEHOLD INCOME

Area Activation and Investment

THE GOOD LIFE DISTRICT

The Good Life District will be centered around a 100,000 SF water park with a retractable roof, which allows visitors year-round. Official plans to include hotels, dining, retail, and other recreational uses!

PRARIE HILL FARM COLLABORATION CAMPUS

Surrounding the Good-Life District will be the Prairie Hill Farms Collaboration. A \$600,000,000 project to contain a state-of-the-art \$200,000,000 REACH innovation and collaboration research facility intended to ultimately bring hundreds of high-paying positions.

This campus will offer a 200,000 SF commercial facility that delivers new national security technology. It will be surrounded by housing, hotels, retail, and other amenities that drive foot traffic.

OFFUTT AIR FORCE BASE

Offutt is one of our country's most important strategic military bases, with 45,000 active and retired military and Department of Defense-affiliated civilian personnel on base and in the area. It has been the host base of headquarters for U.S. Strategic Air Command since 1948. Recently, it had a \$1.5 billion renovation to make it secure and capable for years to come.

LARGE SPORTING EVENTS

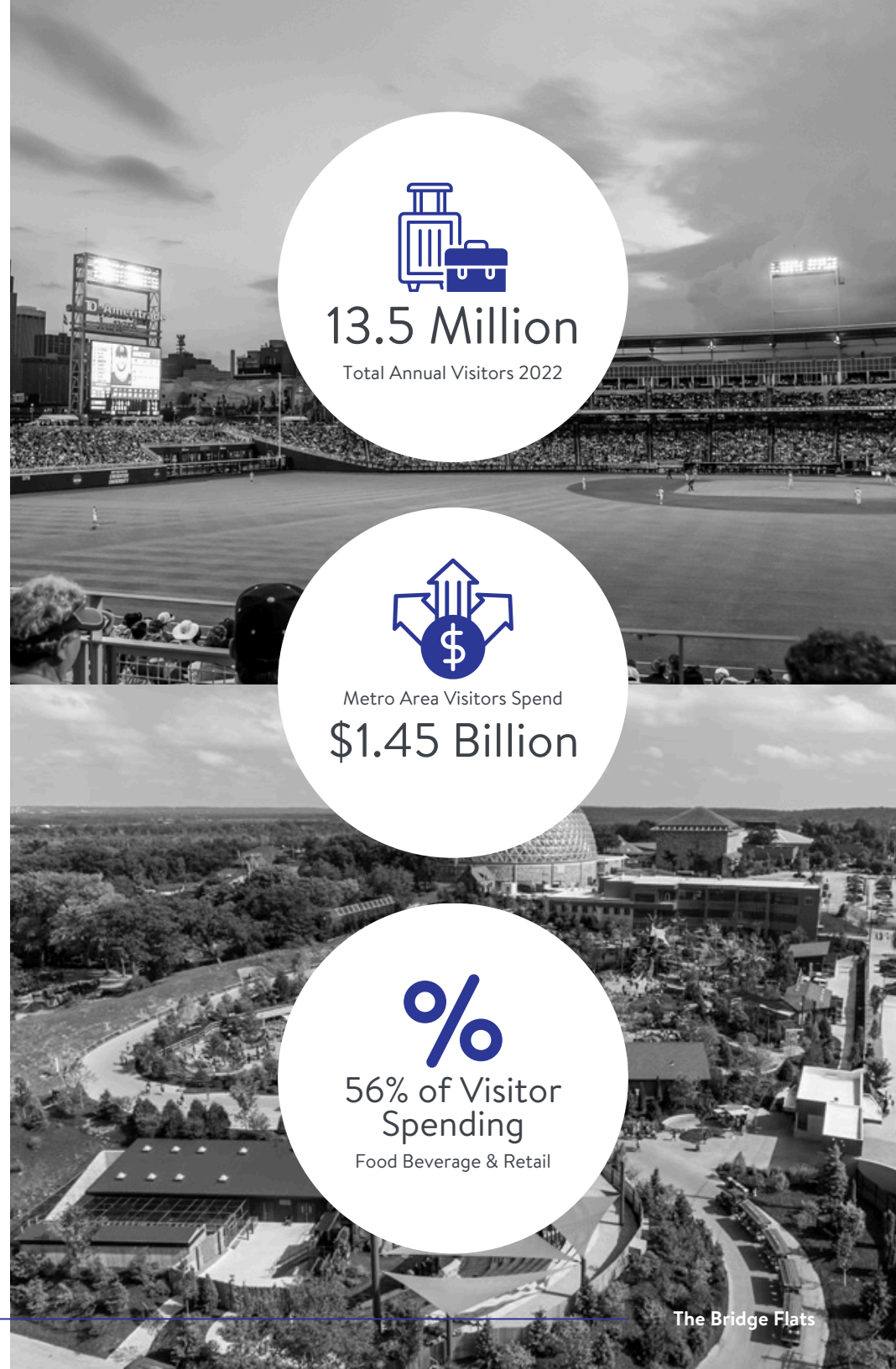
The Metro has hosted the Olympic swim trials, NCAA Basketball March Madness tournament games, and more.

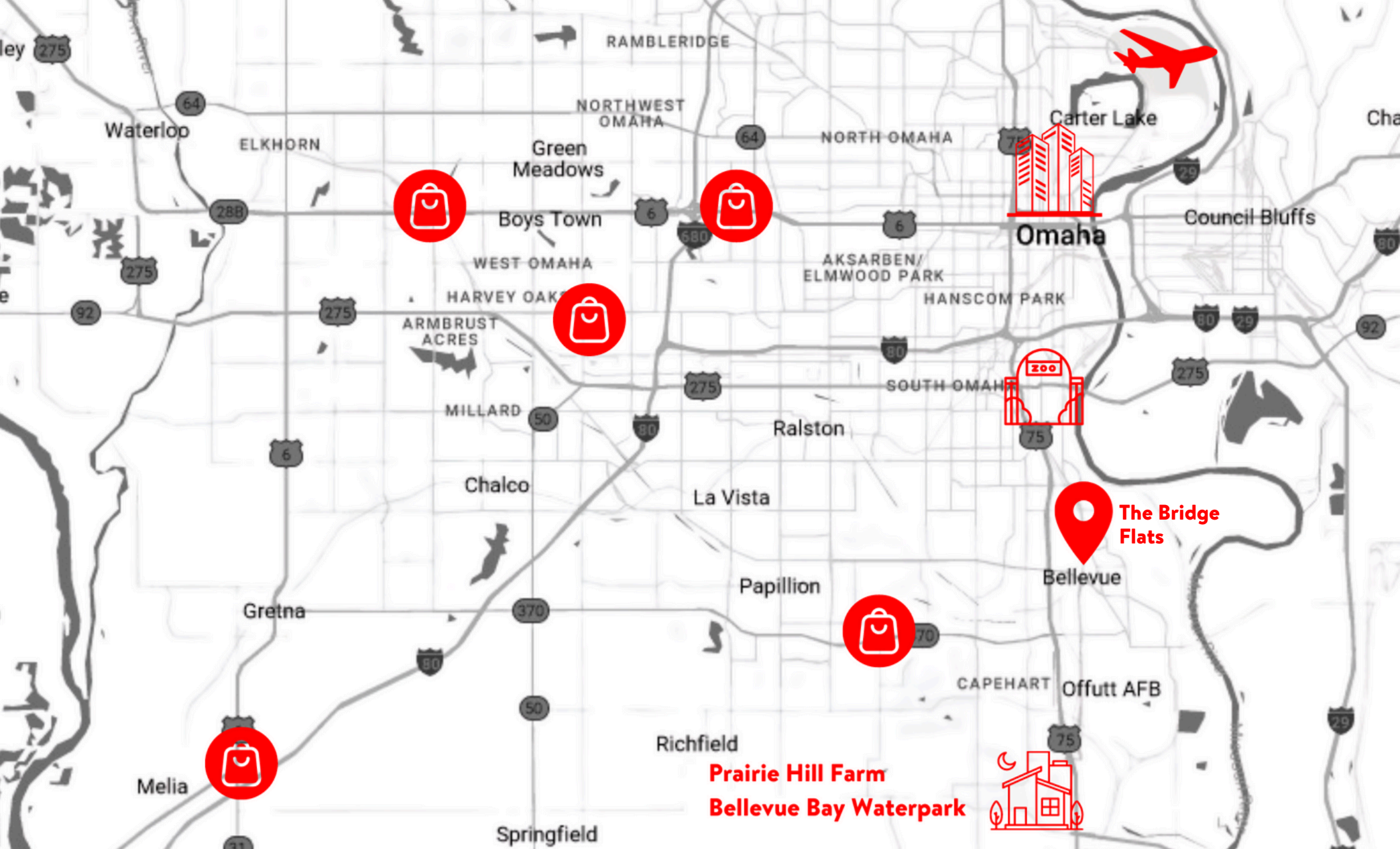
