

Park 536 is located strategically along Mt. Zion Rd (KY 536), just 1.7 miles from I-75/I-71, providing easy interstate access and a short commute to the Cincinnati/Northern Kentucky International Airport.

Travel along Mt. Zion Rd is expected to improve with the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet's 75 Crossings project underway, which will implement the following changes:

- New interchange at Mt. Zion Rd and I-71/75 will feature a double crossover diamond (DCD) interchange
 - Proven to significantly reduce delays
- Mt. Zion Rd widened from three lanes to up to nine lanes
- New upgraded service roads, providing better access to local businesses
- A shared-use path constructed along the north side of Mt. Zion Rd
- New sidewalks along the south side of Mt. Zion Rd
