



### **About** Henagar and Dekalb County

Henagar is located in Dekalb County, Alabama. The town rests on top of Sand Mountain, a southern extension of the Cumberland Plateau. South Salty Creek, a tributary of the Tennessee River flows southwest through the central and southern part of the city. The Sand Mountain Potato Festival is celebrated each July in Henagar, with potatoes, live music, entertainment, arts and crafts, games, and fireworks.







DeKalb County is located in Northeast Alabama, less than two and a half hours from over six major Southeastern markets. I-59 runs through the county, and DeKalb is also close to I-20, I-24, I-65, and I-75. The county's ideal location has made it a popular choice for distribution companies, automotive suppliers, and other manufacturers.
