Current median household income is \$51,509 in the area, compared to \$79,068 for all U.S. households. Median household income is projected to be \$56,911 in five years, compared to \$91,442 all U.S. households.

Current average household income is \$87,650 in this area, compared to \$113,185 for all U.S. households. Average household income is projected to be \$98,948 in five years, compared to \$130,581 for all U.S. households.

Current per capita income is \$38,881 in the area, compared to the U.S. per capita income of \$43,829. The per capita income is projected to be \$44,985 in five years, compared to \$51,203 for all U.S. households.

Currently, 26.9% of the 40,851 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 36.8%, renter occupied; and 36.3% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 57.9% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.1% are renter occupied; and 10.0% are vacant. In 2020, there were 40,730 housing units in the area and 37.2% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 0.07%. Median home value in the area is \$392,259, compared to a median home value of \$355,577 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 3.04% annually to \$455,597.
