



Gotion, Inc. opens its first North American electric manufacturing site vehicle battery in Manteno. By creating 2,600 positions, the plant will produce enough lithium batteries for 500,000 cars/ year at full capacity. This investment will serve as a supply chain line for electric vehicle key manufacturing in Illinois and across the Midwest.

Focused on preparing students for lives of service in meaningful careers in every industry, Olivet has seen strong growth over the last decade, particularly in the Martin D. KANKAKEE COMMUNITY COLLEGE

Kankakee Community College plays a vital role in training qualified workers for today's jobs and keeps adapting to future trends. The college offers certifications, short-term and career preparation, and the first two years of a bachelor's degree. Beyond the classroom, KCC's service areas are designed to help students succeed, offering veterans services, dislocated worker programs with financial assistance, and career search help. In a 2022 survey, 95% of KCC students said their KCC education is worth what they paid, and 93% of students would recommend the college.

The college's career-focused programs are driven by input from advisory committees made up of local business and industry. The college remains affordable, with annual tuition and fees below \$5,000 for full-time enrollment ("cost after aid" on college2career.com), and average financial aid awards above \$2,000 (2022-23 school year); and 86.7% of students receiving financial aid. Through continuing education, business partnerships, career services and adult education, the college also meets the community's needs through custom training, personal enrichment, free GED[®] preparation, and other avenues.
